SILICONE REMOVABLE LIDS WITH POPSICLE STICKS



After filling your molds, cover them with a silicone lid. Through the slot in the lid, slide a popsicle stick into each mold. Before taking your frozen popsicle outdoors, take off the lid and you're left with your delicious popsicle on a disposable stick. No more losing lids! Using these lids is also handy if you want to prepare a lot in advance. When your popsicles are frozen, take them out of the molds and store in bags or containers. Prepare and stock delicious popsicles on disposable sticks!

BPA-FREE PLASTIC LID + HANDLE AND DRIP-TRAY



If you prefer using our reusable plastic handles, or maybe choosing depending on your plans for the popsicles – we've got you covered! Our BoddyGift Popmakers also come with the six regular lids! The handles of the BPA-free plastic lids are just the right size to ensure a great grip. These lids also have a drip tray to prevent those sticky little (or big) fingers.

HIGH-QUALITY 100% WOOD POPSICLE STICKS



The set includes approximately 50 FDA-approved sticks, which fit exactly in the silicone lids' slots.

PREPARATION with Silicone Lids



STEP 1: **Prepare** your favorite **recipe**.

e.g. 1 cup of nectarines, 1 cup of strawberries, 1 cup of orange juice, and a spoonful or two of sugar (optional)

STEP 2: **Prepare** the **tray** with the molds standing on it.

STEP 3: Use the funnel to **fill the molds** with your prepared filling.

STEP 4: **Cover** each mold with a **silicone lid**. Slide a **popsicle stick** through the slot on the silicone lid into each mold.

STEP 5: **Freeze** in an upright position. When your popsicles are frozen you can take the molds out of the tray and place them lying down in the freezer to save space.

STEP 6: **Clean** the funnel. If you have a dishwasher, just pop it in. If you don't, clean it by hand using warm water, detergent, and the custom-sized brush for the funnel's stem.

CONSUMPTION with Silicone Lids



STEP 1: **Remove** as many molds as desired **from** the **freezer**.

STEP 2: **Remove** the **silicone lid** from each mold.

STEP 3: **Hold** each mold under **warm running water** for 15-20 seconds, or until you feel the popsicle starting to loosen.

STEP 4: Gently pulling the stick, **remove** the **popsicle** from the mold.

STEP 5: **Enjoy** indoors or outdoors! You can also just put it back into the freezer in a bag or container, to free up your set.

STEP 6: **Clean** the molds and the silicone lids. If you have a dishwasher, just pop them in. If not, you can wash them with warm water and detergent. Use the custom-sized brush to reach the bottom of the molds.

STEP 7: Dry the set well and **store** in the Lebice bag... Or use them right away to make even more delicious popsicles!

PREPARATION with Plastic Lids



STEP 1: **Prepare** your favorite **recipe**.

e.g. 1 cup of nectarines, 1 cup of strawberries, 1 cup of orange juice, and a spoonful or two of sugar (optional)

STEP 2: **Prepare** the **tray** with the molds standing on it.

STEP 3: Use the funnel to **fill the molds** with your prepared filling.

STEP 4: **Cover** each mold with a **plastic lid**. You don't have to hear a snap, it just has to slide on.

STEP 5: **Freeze** in an upright position. When your popsicles are frozen you can take the molds out of the tray and place them lying down in the freezer to save space.

STEP 6: **Clean** the funnel. If you have a dishwasher, just pop it in. If you don't, clean it by hand using warm water, detergent, and the custom-sized brush for the funnel's stem.

CONSUMPTION with Plastic Lids



STEP 1: **Remove** as many molds as desired **from** their place in the **freezer**.

STEP 2: **Hold** each mold **under warm running water** for 15 to 20 seconds, or until you feel the popsicle starting to loosen in the mold.

STEP 3: **Remove** the **popsicle** by its handle from the mold.

STEP 4: **Enjoy** indoors or outdoors and share with family and friends for maximum popsicle pleasure!

STEP 5: **Clean** the molds and the plastic lids. If you're lucky enough to have a dishwasher, just pop them in. If not, don't worry. You can wash them perfectly well with some warm water and detergent. Use the custom-sized brush to reach the bottom of the molds.

STEP 6: Dry the set well and **store** in the Lebice bag... Or use them straight away to make even more delicious popsicles!
