Located in beautiful Charleston, South Carolina, our socks are primarily designed, engineered, and manufactured in-house using our own knitting machines, giving us the ability to manage and refine our process to perfection. Our durable and comfortable, eco-friendly socks are crafted from yarn derived from the purest Alpaca fiber sourced from Peru. We put ourselves in our customer's shoes to ensure that our socks are the right 'fit' for the intended purpose.

About the people in the company







Ruth Mogrovejo established Latin Collection in 1990 as a family business along with her sister, Aydee, and niece, Azucena. She grew up in the Andean mountain town of Juliaca, Peru, the country's folkloric center and a hub of skilled textile artisans. Motivated by their creative example, Ruth learned knitting, sewing, design, and arts and crafts.

Latin Collection's initial focus involved designing fashionable garments such as scarves, gloves, and hats inspired by nature and Inca/modern art. The company employs Peruvian artisans who transform yarn into unique, wearable art utilizing premium alpaca, baby alpaca, and pima cotton. Many of these artisans support themselves and their families through their work with Latin Collection.

In the early 2000's Latin Collection began designing a line of Alpaca socks known as My Comfy, becoming one of the first companies to bring socks from Peru to America. By 2012, Ruth's son Samy, who now helps run the company, assisted in opening a sock factory in Charleston, one of the first to make socks from alpaca. They have since expanded their product line to include sports, dress, hiking, workman's, medical, leisure, and heavy sock varieties.

The factory

Our 3,000-square foot Charleston-based factory includes seven machines, 1,000-square feet of manufacturing, and 1,000-square feet of inventory. Working with mills to source Alpaca, we buy our yarn from South America which is combined with other materials to make My Comfy Socks' proprietary blend. The factory features finished product and raw materials, and we keep our entire product line in stock onsite. Due to increased demand, we have outgrown our current space and have plans to expand and build a new 4,500-square foot facility.



Every aspect of our product at My Comfy serves a purpose, from the socks down to the raw material. If the sock doesn't come out perfect, we repair it and sell it at a discount as an Almost Perfect or Misfit sock. If a sock is damaged and doesn't meet our strict FFF standard (form, fit, and function) we repair the sock and donate it to people in need. We are currently sending our donated socks to the brave soldiers fighting on the front lines in Ukraine.

Any scrap material that cannot be used in the manufacture of our socks is saved for recycling. The scrap will be sent to a mill where it is shredded and converted back into yarn used to make socks called "Reinvented socks." Our yarn comes







packaged in cardboard cones, and once the yarn is spent, we save the cones and donate them to local libraries and rec centers to be used for arts and crafts and other fun activities. The large trimmings from the socks are also collected and donated for arts and crafts, while the small trimmings from the machines are given to local artisans who incorporate them in their handiwork. Most trimming material goes into stuffing for pillows or stuffed animals.

History of alpaca

Native to South America, alpacas are believed to have been created as a cross-bred hybrid of its relatives the llama and the vicuna around 6,000 years ago. They derive from the Camelidae family which also consists of camels and guanacos. Their typical life span is 15-20 years. Adults stand about three feet tall and generally weigh between 100-200 pounds. They live in the Andean Highlands, with the largest concentration found in Peru. Referred to by the Incas as the "fiber of the gods," their luxurious wool was once used to make garments for Incan royalty. alpacas raised Today, are primarily for their wool, prized for its warmth and comfort.

At My Comfy, we design and make our own socks. All of our socks are reinforced from heel to toe and throughout the sole. We provide an arch support for a better bond between the sock and the foot. We knit our alpaca yarn throughout the interior of our socks, providing ultimate softness for your feet. Nylon is used on the outside, allowing premium strength for wear and tear. Our socks are made with the perfect blend of Alpaca (between 45-55%) to harness the material's optimum features while making the sock as durable as possible. Alpaca is superior to Merino wool, wicking and insulating better, keeping your feet dry and preventing fungal growth.




