## **Fabric Requirements**

4 fat quarters (one for each Fabric A square; (*Note: Two blocks can be cut from one fat quarter if you want to repeat fabrics.*) 1/4 yard for Fabric B (accent) 1/2 yard for Fabric C (background, includes sashing) 1/2 yard for outer border 1/3 yard for binding 11/8 yards for backing 40" x 40" batting

# Cutting

## From Fabric A:

• Cut four  $9^{1/2^{"}}$  squares.

#### From Fabric B:

Cut three 2" x width-of-fabric (WOF) strips.
Sub-cut eight 2" x 5" strips and eight 2" x 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.

Fabrics A: Michael-C1388 Multi

Fabric B: Soho-Black

Fabric C: Soho-White

Michael-C1710 Turquoise

Outer border and binding: Ocean-C6155 Deep

Michael-C9986 Blue

Michael-C1824 Multi

• Cut one 1<sup>1</sup>/2<sup>"</sup> square.

#### From Fabric C:

- Cut three 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut eight 2" x 5" strips and eight 2" x 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.
- Cut six 1<sup>1</sup>/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut four 1<sup>1</sup>/2" x 12<sup>1</sup>/2" sashing strips. Save the remaining four strips for the inner border.

## From outer border fabric:

• Cut four 3" x WOF strips.

## From binding fabric:

• Cut four 2<sup>1</sup>/2" x WOF strips.

# **Block Construction**

All seam allowances are 1/4" and pieces are sewn right sides together. Note the orientation of one-way prints.

- 1. Decide which  $9^{1/2}$ " square Fabric A will be in each corner and label them by their location: upper left, upper right, lower left and lower right.
- 2. Sew one 2" x 5" Fabric B strip and one 2" x 5" Fabric C strip end to end to make a side unit. Make a total of eight side units.
- 3. Following Figure 1 and noting any fabric orientation, sew one side unit to each side of the 91/2" Fabric A square for the upper left block. Repeat for the Fabric A lower right block.
- 4. Sew one  $2^{"} \times 6^{1/2"}$  Fabric B strip and one  $2^{"} \times 6^{1/2"}$ Fabric C strip end to end to make a top/bottom unit. Make a total of eight units.
- 5. Referring to Figure 1 for fabric placement, sew the top/bottom units to the blocks. Each block should measure  $12^{1/2^{"}}$  square
- 6. Following Figure 2, repeat steps 2-5 to make the upper right block and lower left block.

# Quilt Top Assembly

- 7. Referring to the table topper photos for block placement and orientation, lay out the blocks in two rows of two each block each.
- 8. Sew a  $1^{1}/2^{"}$  x  $12^{1}/2^{"}$  Fabric C sashing strip to the right side of the upper left block. Sew the upper right block to the sashing strip. Repeat to sew the  $1^{1/2^{"}} \times 12^{1/2^{"}}$  Fabric C sashing strip to the second row. -----

- 9. Sew a  $1^{1/2}$ " x  $12^{1/2}$ " Fabric C sashing strip to the 1<sup>1</sup>/2" Fabric B square. Sew a 1<sup>1</sup>/2" x 12<sup>1</sup>/2" Fabric C sashing strip to other side of the 11/2" Fabric B square. Sew this sashing unit between rows 1 and 2, aligning adjacent seams.
- 10. Measure the topper center length and cut two strips that measurement from the 11/2" x WOF Fabric C strips. Sew one strip to each side of the topper.
- 11. Measure the topper center width and cut two 1<sup>1</sup>/2" Fabric C strips that measurement. Sew one strip to the top and the other to the bottom of the table topper.
- 12. Repeat steps 10-11 for outside border.

# Finishing

- 13. Layer the table topper, batting and backing, and quilt as desired.
- 14. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the topper front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
- 15. Fold the binding to the topper underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the back.
