## PAPER BOUQUET FOR MOTHER'S DAY

### SUPPLIES NEEDED

- Printed template
- Crayons or colored pencils
- Paper

All Mother's deserve flowers for Mother's Day - so why not make her a beautiful Boquet.

Color the included template.

Fold a couple tiimes along the dotted lines and viola flowers for mum!



# MOTHER'S DAY HANDPRINT FLOWER POT

## SUPPLIES NEEDED

- Paint
- Printed Flower pot/poem



Cover your child's palm and fingers with the supplied paint.

Place hand (palm side down) on paper to transfer the paint as shown.

Repeat with other hand.

# DOILY HANDPRINT BOWL



## SUPPLIES NEEDED

- Tissue paper
- Balloon
- Doily
- Glue / tape
- Sharpie
- Scissors
- Paintbrush
- Cup

Cut edge off doily - stack and glue the edges

Trace hand on doily & cut out hand

Lay hand on tissue paper (stacked tissue multiple layers)

Fill balloon, tape to top of cup and cover in glue

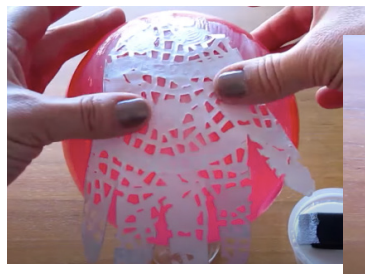
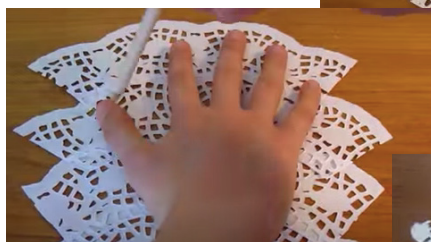
First layer doily hand as this will be your top layer. Cover doily in glue and keep layering tissue paper and glue - repeat the process for all layers of tissue.

Cover the last sheet of tissue with glue and let dry 24 hours

Once dry -Remove cup and pop balloon remove balloon

Cut around the finger shapes. Seal the edges with glue

Write a personalized note and affix it on the bottom of the bowl. Cover with glue.





# PAPER PLATE & CUPCAKE LINER FISH

## SUPPLIES NEEDED

- Paper plate
- Cupcake liner
- Crayons, paint or markers
- Glue
- Black marker

We love paper plate crafts and we love cupcake liner crafts so we combined those two fun materials and made paper plate & cupcake liner fish!

First color them as this fish will look way more fancy in color! You can also color the cupcake liners (just make sure the colors are not too "wet").

Cut a triangle shape out of the paper plate (1/6th or 1/8th). The triangle shape will be used as tail and the opening will be mouth.

Cut the cupcake liners into quarters (or fifths, sixths, ...) and start gluing them onto the paper plate. We're making scales! Leave the front part of the fish where the mouth is scale free! With a black marker draw an eye on the fish (you can also cut the oval shape out of white paper and draw a black dot there to make the eye pop out even more).

Glue on the tail and fins!



# SUPER HERO MOM HERSHEY'S BAR

## YOU WILL NEED:

- Superhero template
- Carstock
- Markers
- Yarn
- Glue
- Scissors
- Tape

1. Cut out a superhero face, tag and cape. Use your markers to color in the features on the superhero face like eyes, nose and a mouth. Then color in the heart on the gift tag.

2. Cut three strands of yarn for the hair. Glue them down at the top of your superhero with tacky glue. You might also like to add bangs if your Mom has them.

3. Place the candy bar in the center of the superhero cape with the bottom of the candy bar at the bottom of the cape. Fold the top two corners inward and make a crease to create your cape. Remove the candy bar, add two pieces of tape in the center of the cape and stick your candy bar in place. Add a piece of tape on each corner of the folded cape and stick them down onto the candy bar.

4. Add a piece of tape at the bottom of the candy bar and place your gift tag on it. Finish your DIY superhero Mother's Day gift by taping the face at the top of the candy bar.
