BUNNY BAG

SUPPLIES NEEDED

- White paper bag
- Pipe cleaners
- White & Colored cardstock
- Pom-pom


This week's craft will come in a white gift bag. Have your child decorate the bag to look like a bunny!

- 1. We are going to start with making the bunny whiskers. To do this, simply take 2 silver pipe cleaners and twist them together in the middle.
- 2. Now it is time to add a bunny nose. Glue the pom-pom to the center of the pipe.



- 3. Then glue the nose and whiskers combo on to the white paper bag to create a bunny nose. You will want to glue this a little above the half-way mark on the bag. Then draw the eyes on!
- 4. To make the bunny ears, take your white and colored pieces of paper and cut out two ears from each color. Make the colored ones a bit smaller and glue the them on to the white ones.
- 5. Glue your ears on the inside of the paper bag to create your Easter Bunny!

WINDCHIME








- 1. Paint the wood shapes as desired.
- 2. Cut string into 6 pieces
 - (1) 7" in length
 - (5) 5" in length
- 3. Use the longest string to create a hanger for the top shape.
- 4. Use the remaining string to attach chimes and wood shapes.

PINWHEEL

Kids love adding their own artwork to these pretty pinwheels. These pinwheels love to catch the wind!

We recommend using crayons, colored pencils, washable markers, permanent markers, tempera or acrylic paint to decorate.

- 1. Color, paint or decorate the paper pinwheel and flower on the front and back of th paper as desired.
- 2. Insert the paper flower onto the small end of the colored plug.
- 3. Fold the pinwheel corners with holes towards the center hole of the paper pinwheel.
- 4. Insert the plug into each of the holes in the pinwheel.
- 5. Attach the plug to the pinwheel mechanism.





6. Slide the plastic straw into the large end of the pinwheel mechanism.

UNICORN MAGIC WAND



Color the unicorn topper as desired. Make sure to color both sides!

Tie the strips to the straw as shown above. Fold the topper and adhere it to the top of the straw as shown above.

Make sure to cast a magic spell!!!

PAINT MONSTER

SUPPLIES NEEDED

- Straw
- Paint
