
How to get DDNS Address

1. On the Device, MAC Address & Barcode sticker looks like below

(Find the Sticker on the bottom side of the Port Digger Device)

0C:EF:AF:C4:KA:D6



(Above Information is NOT from your device, you must check your sticker)

2. The last 4 digits are your DDNS address

KAD6.OPENPORT.US

(This is a sample address, your address is not KAD6, You must check the sticker.)

3. Type KAD6.OPENPORT.US into the Mobile App.

(you can type KAD6.OPENPORT.US into Mobile App or Desktop App)

How to get Local IP Address of the DVR?

To get Local IP Access Support, only [MKII \(Network\) supported](#). If you purchased MKII (Network) Simply open up any web browser (try on your smartphone), and type the DDNS Address:2018 (like example below) then it will tell you what current DVR LAN IP is (once again, KAD6 is not yours, find your 4 characters from the sticker, also make sure Port Digger LED light is ON Solid)

KAD6.OPENPORT.US:2018

Typing DDNS address colon 2018 will tell you what the DVR local IP is.
