## Odd Count* Peyote Bracelet

*Can also be stitched as even count - ignore the gold edge beads on left side of the bracelet panel while you stitch the straight (no decrease) portion. Add the gold edge using brick stitch before decreasing to a point at each end. Leave a long $12 "$ tail to use later and begin stitching at the star.

Materials: 7" panel, size $11^{0}$ Delica bead colors listed

1 \mathrm{~g} \text { Red \#753 } & 1 \mathrm{~g} \text { silver lined Pink \#684 }
\end{array}

## Hidden Thread Peyote Decrease:



1. To decrease in Peyote stitch without thread showing on the side you need to reposition your thread so it will not show on the decrease edges. To reposition the thread pass through the bead (c) directly below the last bead passed through (a), stitching from the outside of the panel towards the center of the panel, exit bead and pull the thread all the way through to front of panel.
2. Pass thread between last bead passed through on top row (a) and last bead added on top row (b) and under the thread between them, stitching from front to back of panel.
3. Bring thread all the way through (b) and tug gently to settle into place, with thread in its new starting position you can now continue beading as before.
4. Repeat steps 1-3 to decrease at either side of rows as needed. Repeat to decrease other end of bracelet panel.
5. Use tail threads to attach clasp of choice. Hide threads and trim.

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
