## Lavender Pruning Cheat Sheet

Essential Tips with Checkboxes for Healthy Lavender

When	to	Prune

- Best time: Late summer or early autumn after flowering.
- Avoid winter or early spring pruning to protect new growth.

## → How to Prune

- Trim back about one-third of the plant to form a neat mound.
- Never cut into the woody base it won't regrow.
- Always cut above a set of leaves.
- Remove spent flowers and any dead or damaged stems.
- Don't over-prune too much cutting can weaken the plant.

## Common Mistakes to Avoid

- Pruning too late in the season (risk of frost damage).
- Cutting into woody stems (no regrowth).
- Skipping annual pruning (leads to woody, sparse plants).
- Overwatering after pruning (lavender prefers dry conditions).
