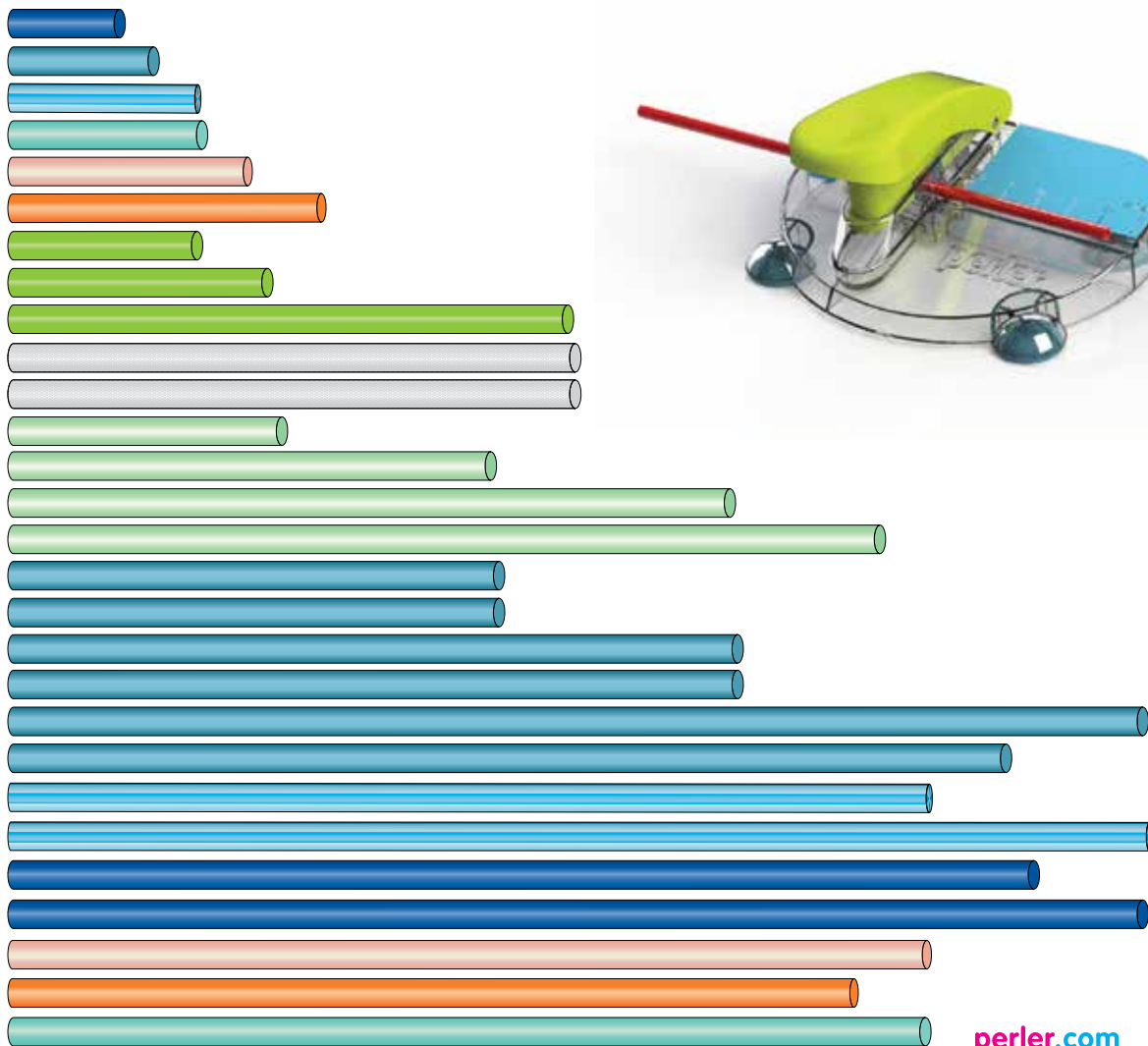
Instructions

1. This design uses a colorful combination of beads and stems cut to size. Use the stem clipper to cut the stems to a variety of lengths.
2. Place the beads on the pegboards following the patterns. If you are using a clear pegboard, slide the actual-size pattern underneath it.
3. Ask an adult to fuse your designs—see page 5 for further instructions. For assembly, see page 6.

CUT YOUR BEAD STEM PIECES

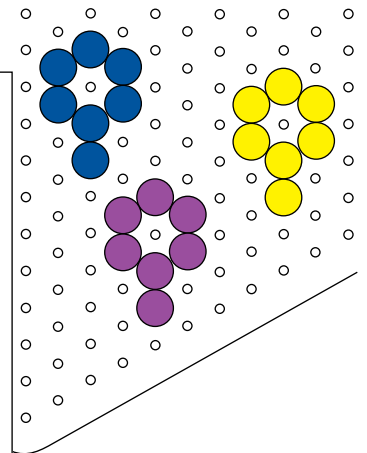
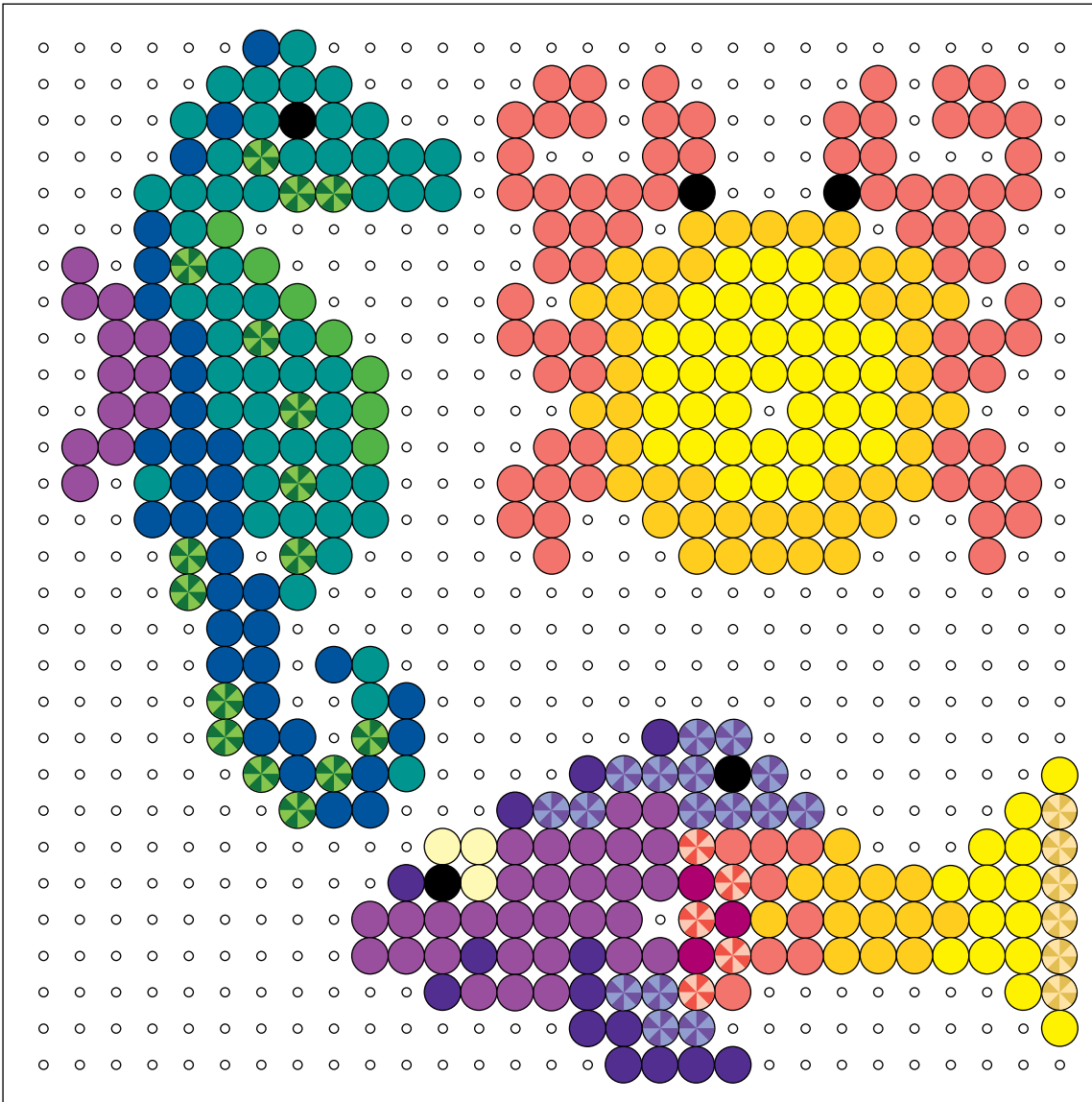
Cut varying lengths of ocean and reef colors of bead stems. We recommend the following colors:

- Dark Blue
- Pearl Light Blue
- Sky Blue Stripe
- Light Green
- Pearl Light Pink
- Orange
- Kiwi Lime

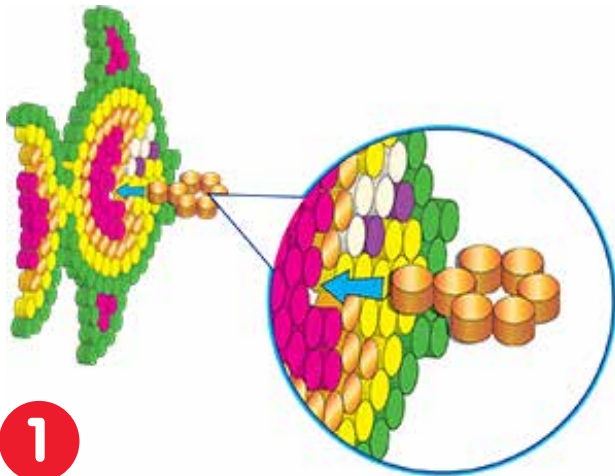


Fusing Instructions—Only Adults Iron



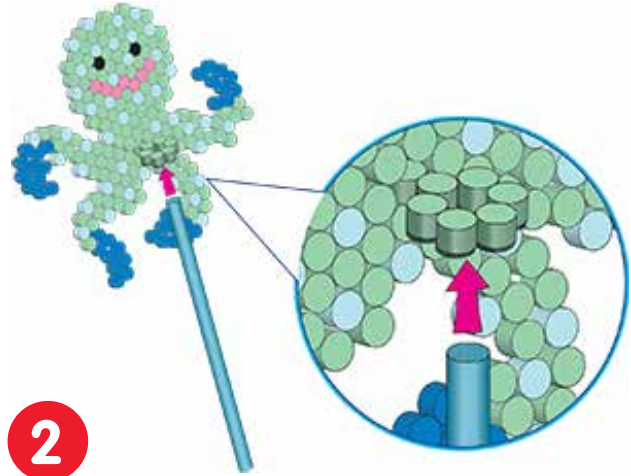
1. Place your pegboard on a flat, heat-safe surface.
2. Set a household iron to the medium setting. Place ironing paper over the pegboard. In a circular motion, begin to iron the project. Do not press down with the iron. As the beads begin to fuse, you will see circles of the beads start to show through the paper. When ironed properly, the beads will still have an open center. Let the design cool.
3. Remove the paper and bead design from the peg board. Flip the design over to expose the non-fused side. Repeat step two. Let cool completely.

NOTE: Beads need heat for about 10-20 seconds per side to fuse evenly. Lift the paper occasionally to see how the beads are fusing. Depending on the size of the project, additional heating time may be required. DO NOT OVER-IRON the beads as it will make the centers of the beads close and can make the assembly you do with your project more challenging.



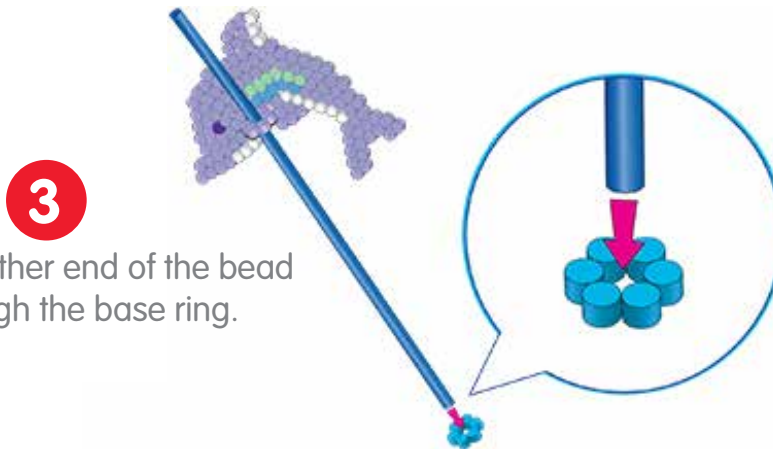

Insert each creature's attachment ring into the slot.



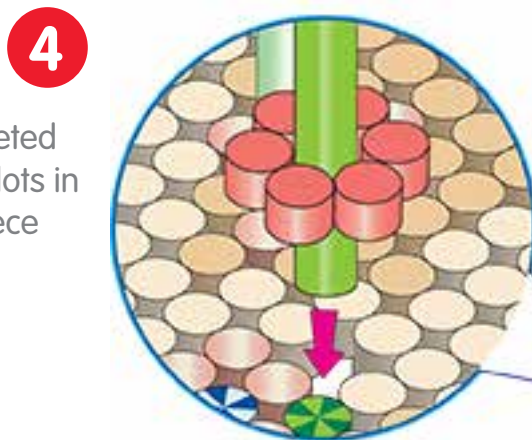

Insert a bead stem into the attachment ring and position along the stem as desired.

Insert the other end of the bead stem through the base ring.

Insert the completed pieces into the slots in the base reef piece and arrange as desired.
