
2019+ Chevy Silverado Mud Flap Installation Instructions

FRONT HARDWARE

- (2) Clamp Brackets
 (4) Large Fender Washers
 (4) Split Lock Washers
 (4) ¼-20 Nuts
- (6) #6 x 1" Hex screws
- (6) Small Fender Washers

REAR HARDWARE

- (2) Clamp Brackets
 (4) Large Fender Washers
 (4) Split Lock Washers
 (4) ¼-20 Nuts
- (4) #6 x 1" Hex Screws(4) Small Fender Washers






Front Mud Flap Installation Instructions

Important: Turning front wheels is recommended to allow access for installation

NOTE: Flaps can be installed with or without OEM plastic rock guard. Removing this rock guard, however, exposes a mounting hole on outside of fender.

- 1. Remove Factory Screws (FIGURE 2)
- 2. Start by attaching Clamp Bracket to flap at top 2 mounting locations on the flap (FIGURE1, 3, 4 & 5) using large fender washers, lock washers & nuts (NOTE: Leave bracket loose on flap). Next attach flap to fender well factory location B using hex screw and mall fender washer.
- 3. Once attached at location B, fasten clamp bracket to fender well lip by making sure "clamping" portion of bracket is 'pinching' the lip. (NOTE: Tighten slightly to allow adjustment and alignment while fastening at remaining locations A & C). Check alignment with level and tighten all fasteners when desired vertical and horizontal alignment is complete. NOTE: DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN NUTS ON CLAMP BRACKET STUDS AS CROSSTHREADING MAY OCCUR.



4. Repeat above steps on opposite side.

Rear Flap Installation Instructions

Important: It is recommended to read through all instructions prior to starting install

- 1. Remove Factory screws at 2 locations (See corresponding locations A and B in FIGURE 7)
- Start by attaching Clamp Bracket to flap (Same as front install) at top 2 mounting locations on flap using large fender washers, lock washers & nuts (NOTE: Leave bracket loose on flap). Next attach flap to fender well factory location B FIGURE 7 using hex screw and small fender washer.
- 3. Once attached at location B, fasten clamp bracket to fender well lip by making sure "clamping" portion of bracket is 'pinching' the lip. (NOTE: Tighten slightly to allow adjustment and alignment while fastening at remaining location A). Check alignment with level and tighten all fasteners when desired vertical and horizontal alignment is complete. NOTE: DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN NUTS ON CLAMP BRACKET STUDS AS CROSSTHREADING MAY OCCUR.
- 4. Repeat above steps for opposite side.
