Tools Needed: Electric Drill , ³/₁₆" Drill Bit , and #3 Phillips Screwdriver

Mounting Rack to Wall

- 1. Locate stud and drill pilot holes for Phillips Head Screws using $\frac{3}{16}$ drill bit. Use any two of the three holes on the mounting plate.
- 2. Mount paddle rack flush to wall with Phillips Head Screws and Washers.

Pro Tip: An old woodworkers trick is to rub the screw threads on a bar of soap for easy installation.

Mounting Rack to Free-Standing System

Mount paddle rack to Free-Standing post using $2\frac{1}{2}$ x $\frac{5}{16}$ hex bolt and nut (hardware not supplied). Use top and bottom holes on the mounting plate (4" apart).

Mounting Rack to Grid Wall or Slat Wall

Attach paddle racks to slat wall or grid wall using plates. Use the top two holes on the mounting plate (2" apart).

- 1. Use a Slat Wall Mount Plate (Model #31-5582)
- 2. Use a Grid Wall Mount Plate (Model #31-5581)

Paddles rest in grooves of rubber pads.
