

Mounting Instructions

Tools Needed: Tape Measure, Electric Drill, ¹/₈" Drill Bit, and #2 Phillips Head Driver

The length of your boat will determine Strap spacing. Ideal Strap spacing is 40% of total boat length, (boat length X 0.4 = spacing).

- 1. Locate the wall studs where Strap Storage System will be mounted.
- 2. Use the mounting plate as a template to mark the hole locations. Push a mounting screw into wall to mark the locations for holes.



Pro Tip: An old woodworkers trick is to rub the screw threads on a bar of soap for easy installation.

- 3. Use the ¹/₈" drill bit to drill all 3 holes. It is important that at least 2 screws from each mounting bracket goes into a wood stud. If you missed the stud with the third hole, screw in a plastic anchor. Use #2 Phillips Head Driver to screw Phillips Head Screws through bracket and into plastic anchor.


 Note: Take care not to over tighten the screw in the plastic anchor. Extra plastic anchors are supplied should this occur. See Photo.
- 4. Adjust the strap lengths to gently cradle your boat.
