Much like a great pair of shoes, the key to effectively transporting your watercraft with a center cart is properly fitting the cart to your watercraft. When the cart fits your watercraft, transport becomes easy. With a poor fit, the watercraft is awkward to load and slides around on the cart and may even fall off due to load shifting. No one cart can fit the myriad of hull shapes.

Send a couple pictures of the bottom of your kayak to ShowUsYourBottom@suspenz.com and we will email you back with the carts that best fit your watercraft.

In your email with the photos, please include: **1) Manufacturer 2) Model of boat & 3) Length of boat.** Also include the **type of terrain** for your travels: smooth to small bumps and rocks, or beach sand, or rough ruts and rocks.

Photos: The most helpful pictures are taken along the centerline of the watercraft with a couple of measuring sticks to show width and depth. See samples below. Place the yardstick near the center of the boat (*center carts are positioned just aft of center to fit the balance point of the boat*) and locate the 18" mark so it is over the port-starboard centerline. Move the yardstick fore-aft on the boat to avoid drive systems.

Align your camera to shoot along the centerline of the boat achieving the delicate compromise that:

- Shows the full width of the boat
- Is angled so that the numbers on the yardstick are readable

For complicated hulls take several pictures to show the width – depth contour of the hull.

A couple of general picture examples are shown below:
