


IN-DOOR-CA-001 IN-DOOR-CA-002


Passenger Side Removal: keep all components removed from machine.



Passenger Side Removal continued:




## Passenger Side Door Reference




Passenger Door Installation: do not tighten hardware completely unless noted.

- Assemble Striker Mount, Passenger (E) and Striker Bracket, Passenger (F) together with hardware shown.
- Install Shoulder Bolt and Sealing Washer to Striker Bracket, Passenger (F).



#### **Passenger Door Installation continued:**

- Secure Striker Mount, Passenger (E) to Handle and Frame with hardware shown.
- Secure Striker Bracket, Passenger (F) to Buckle stud with stock nut.



#### Passenger Door Installation continued:

- Secure Door, Passenger (B) to machine, where Protector Tube was located, with stock hardware.
- Close Door, Passenger (**B**) completely so that Latch engages.
- Align to machine and tighten all hardware completely.






Driver Side Removal: keep all components removed from machine.




#### **Driver Side Door Reference**




Driver Door Installation: do not tighten hardware completely unless noted.

- Assemble Striker Mount, Driver (C) and Striker Bracket, Driver (D) together with hardware shown.
- Install Shoulder Bolt and Sealing Washer to Striker Bracket, Driver (D).



Driver Door Installation continued: do not tighten hardware completely unless noted.

- Secure Door, Driver (A) to machine, where Protector Tube was located, with stock hardware.
- Close Door, Driver (A) completely so that Latch engages.
- Align to machine and tighten all hardware completely.



<u> Install hardware in order shown on page 8.</u>

Due to manufacturer changes, slight interference between stock plastic and provided Shoulder Bolt may occur.
