



Raise Cargo Box before beginning.

- Remove Side Nets from both sides of machine.





- Remove hardware shown from Floor. Repeat for opposite side.



- Unbolt and remove Seat and Seat Back from Frame.
- Remove hardware shown from each side.

Do not tighten hardware completely when installing.

- Secure Door to Roll Cage with hardware shown.




IN-DOOR-P-RAN570

- Seat Back must be trimmed.
- Close Door and mark Seat Back where interference occurs.



- Trim Seat Back.

- Secure Door to Frame with stock hardware.
- If interference still occurs, continue trimming Seat Back.






IN-DOOR-P-RAN570

- Secure Door to Floor with hardware shown.
- Tighten all hardware completely.
- Repeat steps for opposite Door.
