


# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- SuperATV does not recommend keeping Windshield installed while transporting on an open air trailer. Remove or secure with straps.
- This item is not returnable if the protective film has been removed.







#### Windshield Cleaning:


- Do not use Rain-X<sup>®</sup>, Plexus<sup>®</sup> or any other protector, wax, or polish.
- Do not use window cleaning fluids (Windex, 409, etc) or any solvents (gasoline, denatured alcohol, acetone, etc).
- Never use abrasive cleaners, abrasive pads, or gritty cloths.
- Do not use a windshield wiper blade or install a motorized windshield wiper
- Never use razor blades, scrapers, squeegees, brushes, etc.
- 1. Thoroughly rinse Windshield to float off dirt and mud.
- 2. Using a soft cloth, or microfiber cloth, clean Windshield with warm water and a gentle detergent. Baby shampoo, rubbing alcohol, or hand washing soap can also be used.
- 3. To prevent water spots, use a chamois to blot Windshield dry.



## Soak Seal in hot water before cutting or installing to increase flexibility.

Install Seal around Lower (B) in location shown.







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
- Install Hinges (H) and Supports (G) to Upper (A) with hardware shown; tighten.




- Secure Upper (A) to Frame with hardware shown; do not tighten.




- Place Clamps (J) onto Frame in locations shown; do not tighten.







- Place Lower (B) onto machine.
- Secure to Hinges (H) with hardware shown.



- Place Actuator wiring in location shown. Repeat for passenger side.




- See page 2 and route Harness.



- Connect Actuators to Harnesses.



- RED wire from Harness to Terminal with thick red wire.
- BLACK wire from Harness to Terminal with thick black wire.




#### Before drilling any holes, check behind area to be drilled for any interference.

### **Switch Mounting:**

- User may install Switch in location different than shown.
- Verify that Harness will reach components before mounting.
- Remove stock Knockout or cut a new location.
- Connect wiring to Actuator wiring and 12V connection.
- Secure Switch.

Before permanently mounting Switch, SuperATV recommends testing after all components have been installed.

- Connect Harness and install Switch.







- After opening and closing Windshield, Actuator Clamps may need fine tuning in order for Windshield to properly close. Move Clamps (J) assembly, as shown on page 6, in small increments up or down Cage.
