


INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Soft Cab Enclosure Roof: for Polaris RZR® Trail / S

Notes:

- Hook and Loop Fasteners should be applied at a temperature of 70°F or above.
- Thouroughly clean and dry any area where Hook and Loop Fasteners will be installed.
- Installing and adjusting Soft Cab is easier with two people.
- When cleaning Soft Cab, use soap and water only. Do not use detergent, window cleaner, solvents.
- Do not fold Soft Cab before storing. Roll Soft Cab to store.
- Do not discard packaging until product has been successfully installed.
- SuperATV does not recommend keeping Roof installed while transporting on an open air trailer.



- If no Windshield is present, Bracket must be installed.
- SuperATV strongly recommends Bracket installation regardless.





Disregard this page if Bracket is going to be installed. Go to "Hook and Loop to Cage Installation" and page 5.

- Place Roof onto machine.
- Center Roof side-to-side and front-to-back.
- Install a piece of Hook and Loop to Windshield where Front Flap will fasten to.





- Secure Front Flap of Roof to Hook and Loop.

Disregard this page if Bracket is going to be installed. Go to "Hook and Loop to Cage Installation" and page 5.

- Place Roof on Windshield / Hood as shown.

- Install Hook and Loop to Cage.






Go to page 9 if Bracket is NOT going to be installed.



Bracket installation continued


See following page if machine has a SuperATV Windshield.


- Install Bracket to machine with hardware shown; tighten.




Bracket to Windshield mounting

- SuperATV Full and Glass Windshields will require (2) holes for Bracket mounting.
 - Place Bracket onto Windshield. Center, measure, and mark hole locations.
- Remove Bracket and drill holes. Holes should be large enough for Ø8mm bolts.
 - Return to previous page.





- Hook Trimlok to Bracket.



- Pull Roof to back of machine.



- Fasten rear of Roof to previously installed Hook and Loop. Roof should be pulled tight.



- Secure Flaps to Hook and Loop on Roof. Roof should be pulled tight.



- Cinch all Straps tight.

- If Bracket was installed, tuck Front Flap under Bracket and secure to Roof.
