

SEEDING AND SODDING YOUR LAWN

Jonathan Green Green-Up Lawn Food for Seeding & Sodding is formulated to get new grass seedings off to a great start. It helps your lawn grow strong roots and grow faster and thicker when seeding, overseeding and laying sod. Controlled-Release Nitrogen feeds the grass plants for up to 8 weeks while humates enhance the nutrient efficiency, availability, and the exchange of plant nutrients from the soil.

DIRECTIONS

SUCCESSFUL SEEDING CAN BE ACCOMPLISHED IF THESE PROCEDURES ARE FOLLOWED FOR BOTH OVERSEEDING LAWNS AND ESTABLISHING NEW LAWNS OR SODDING.

1. PREPARATION: Good seed-to-soil contact is very important in order to achieve good germination of the planted grass seed. (a) Mow lawn before seeding.

(b) Rake dead grass and debris and loosen the soil. Add additional topsoil if needed. For larger areas, a rented thatching machine may be easier. Apply seed to the loosened soil and then lightly rake it into the ground. Do not bury the seed more than 1/4" deep.



3. Seed bed should be kept moist for a few weeks while the grass seed germinates. Mow the new grass after it has reached a height of $2^{-1}/2$

Consult your dealer concerning follow-up fertilizer applications and maintenance advice.

SPREADER SETTINGS

The following settings are approximate. This product package applies 3 lbs. of product per 1,000 sq. ft. Settings are based on an average walking speed. Reduce setting for slower speed; raise setting for higher speed. Check your spreader on 250 square feet and adjust to apply at the rate of .75 pounds per 250 square feet. Sweep (do not wash) all fertilizer materials from surfaces immediately after application, because certain fertilizer ingredients can cause permanent stains. Wash out spreader after each use and allow it to dry thoroughly. Treat any exposed metal spreader areas with oil to reduce corrosion.


USAGE TIPS


For rectangular lawns

Apply two header strips across each end for a turning area. Then apply back and forth in the longest direction.

For irregular-shaped lawns Apply a header strip around the entire lawn for a turning

area, then apply back and forth.





• Do not leave spreader open when making turns. • For best results, do not apply on a windy day. • Swath will vary due to weather conditions, product used and walking speed.

• To determine how much coverage you need, multiply the length of your lawn by its width. This equals your total square footage. Deduct any non-lawn areas (house, gardens, walkways, etc.). One bag treats up to 15,000 sq. ft.
