Len Rhodes received diplomas from the Royal Academy of Music, and the London College of Music; with continuing studies in composition at Morley College. He is a Fellow Ermeritus of the Independent (Incorporated) Society of Musicians, UK. His first professional organist position was Clock House Methodist Church, Beckenham, Kent, England, at age 13. Len is signed to Burning Girls Records (UK); and is constantly in demand as a composer and arranger.

Recent work includes commissions from world-renowned violist **Anne Akiko Meyers**; Original Musical Director, Orchestrator and Arranger for **A Night with Janis Joplin -** (US tour 2012-13, arriving on **Broadway**, October 2013); Musical Director, Arranger, and Pianist/Keyboardist for Mike Tyson in the Las Vegas MGM Grand's production of **Mike Tyson – The Undisputed Truth** in April 2012.

Len has ongoing theatre credits throughout the US, Canada, and UK. Compositions, arrangements, and commissions include Anne Akiko Meyers, BBC Radio, Trinity College London, Kennedy Center, and the Virginia Shakespeare Festival.
