Brief History of farming for the North East USA.

Originally much of the Land was forested throughout the Northeast United States.

Immigrants came and cleared the land for farming.

Over time the hillsides eroded, the soil depth grew thin and became relatively unproductive.

Much of the hillsides were allowed to go fallow and are returning to forest.



This example is via census statistics for Cortland County, NY, and was repeated through out the Northeast US.

In 1890' With over 200 saw mills in the county, 96% of all land was cleared mainly for farming!
