### Winegrower's note

The City of Carcassonne is the pride and joy of Languedoc in southern France and is listed as UNESCO World Heritage. The internationally famous medieval town was built in the 13th century and attracts millions of visitors each year. On 14 July, it provides a magical background for firework shows. The vineyards are located at the foot of the medieval fortress, set between the Pyrenees to the south and the Montagne Noire to the north. They benefit from a mild Mediterranean climate thanks to their altitude and the oceanic influence of the Atlantic.



### Winemaker's note

Creating a wine without the use of sulphites requires technical skill and special attention during the winemaking process. The grapes are harvested before daybreak, when the temperatures are at their coolest, and transported to the winery. The pressing is carried out without oxygen in order to preserve the aromas. The pressing is gentle with a selection of the runners. The vinification is made at 18°C to maximize the varietal aromas. A malolactic fermentation is carried out.



### Tasting notes

This wine presents a deep salmon colour.

On the nose, it reveals very fruity notes of wild strawberry and red fruits with hints of citrus.

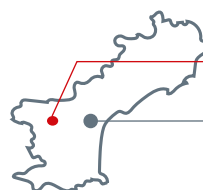
Long on the palate with a nice structure and beautiful freshness.
