## Winegrower's note

Jewel of Languedoc, in the south of France, the City of Carcassonne is classified as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. This medieval city, built during the 13<sup>th</sup> century and with an international reputation, attracts millions of visitors every year. It is the fairy theater of the famous fireworks of July 14<sup>th</sup>. The vineyard, at the foot of this medieval fortress, is located between the Pyrenean mountains and the Black Mountain. It benefits from a Mediterranean climate tempered by the altitude and the oceanic influences of the Atlantic.



## Winemaker's note

Creating a wine without the use of sulfites requires knowledge, technical skills and special attention during the winemaking process. The grapes are harvested before daybreak, when the temperatures are at their coolest, and transported to the winery. The pressing is carried out without oxygen in order to preserve the aromas. The pressing is gentle with a selection of the runners. The winemaking is made at 18°C to maximize the varietal aromas. A malolactic fermentation is carried out.



## Tasting notes

A lively and very aromatic wine with fruity notes of passion fruit and peach, citrus, almond and slightly toasted hints.

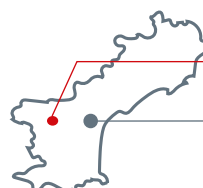
This wine is all about tension and minerality.
