Winegrower's note

Heresie redefines the Corbières wines. It is the expression of a vintage from the Corbières, that symbolizes and transcends the story of the knights from the South of France. This wine is a strong and innovative concept, strongly appreciated by the millenials.



Winemaker's note

The harvesting date is triggered grape variety by grape variety, when the grapes have reached their optimum ripeness after daily tastings. The grapes are picked by hand and undergo a pneumatic pressing as soon as they arrive at the winery. The press juices are separated. After a static settling of the musts, 100% of the juice undergoes an alcoholic fermentation in barrels, with temperature control to preserve the freshness and integrity of the aromas. The maturing is performed in barrels for 7 to 8 months through to the spring equinox, with a regular stirring for two months. After a light fining operation, the wine is bottled.



Tasting notes

This wine has a bright golden yellow colour.

Very expressive and exquisite on the nose, with aromas of dry apricot, grilled almond and very floral notes of hawthorn and broom flower.

Generous and smooth on the palate, round, velvety with brioche aromas.

The finish is tense and very fresh.

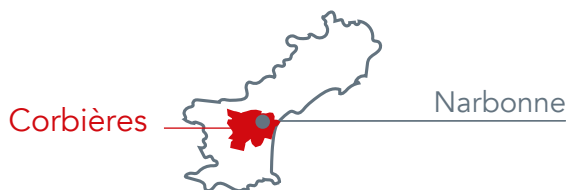
This wine is ideal at 11°C, as an aperitif or with fish, white meat prepared in sauce and with goat cheese.
