Winegrower's note

Lys de Castellum symbolises the royalty of the Middle Ages, conjuring up the majesty of the City of Carcassonne, which is inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List and stands proudly above the valley between the Montagne Noire and the Pyrenees. The vines of this vintage are cultivated organically; a method that respects the environment and produces intensely fruity wines.



Winemaker's note

Our work begins in the vineyards, where we meticulously ensure that the foliage is healthy and well exposed, and that the grapes reach optimal maturity. Plot selection is carried out before mechanical harvesting, followed by direct pressing of the grapes, for the full expression of the fruit. After cooling and settling of the juice, alcoholic fermentation is carried out at a controlled temperature, in order to develop as many aromas as possible.



Tasting notes

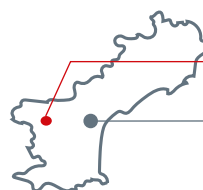
The wine has a pale yellow colour with green hues. The nose reveals its aromatic intensity with citrus, hazelnut and buttery notes. The palate is full, round and smooth, and the finish is very fresh.

Serve at 12°C as an aperitif, or with fish, white meat or fresh cheeses.
