Kitset Wall Unit (KWU) Installation Instruction





The sheet metal support structure known as the Kitset Wall Unit (KWU) has been specifically crafted to simplify the installation process for the DN & KS1150 Corner & Peninsula models.

After assembly, it can sustain wall cladding weighing up to 500kg without transferring any load to the fire.










Attach the KWU to the timber framing (not provided) based on the dimensions indicated above. Start by placing the bottom on the timber, then position the left and right sides on top and secure them using 16 screws sized 8-1 1/4.












Place the top onto the two sides and secure it. Install the 2 hangers as cross braces across the back.

Slide the unit (DN/KS - Peninsula/Corner) into the KWU, utilising the holes on each side to facilitate access while sliding the fire in.











Utilise the provided bend tool to bend the tabs on the top front of each side. Secure the front panel in position at the top. Attach the KWU to the fire using the supplied #8 - 5/8 screws, employing two screws per side.




The top plate of the KWU can be placed in one of two positions based on the desired flue orientation. Position 1 covers the entire top opening, while position 2 involves the plate sliding partially underneath, covering half of the opening.





Flue out from the back or the bottom -use position 1.

Flue out from the top - use position 2.



The top wall lining fixing holes in the KWU can serve for attaching plasterboard or wall cladding using either screws or construction adhesive glue. The access panels are eligible to be covered, as they are not required to be kept accessible for servicing.

Recommended plasterboard screws: Scavenger Head/Bugle Head High Thread plasterboard screws, Size: 6 x (50mm MAX.)

WARNING: The maximum load supported by the KWU is 500kg. The attached wall cannot exceed this.
