# MIXING HENNA SHADES



# **BLONDE (90%) + AUBURN (10%)**

If the Blonde henna is too light or too ashy for your client, make the shade warmer by adding a small amount of Auburn to the Blonde.



## BLONDE (75%) + MEDIUM BROWN (25%)

If you wish to make the Blonde henna darker but not ashy, add a dash of Medium Brown to the mix.



### MEDIUM BROWN (80%) + AUBURN (20%)

You can mix these shades if you want to warm up the 'Medium Brown' and create a vibrant brow look



## **AUBURN (10-20 %)**

You can mix any color you want with Auburn to make it warmer and more reddish. Make sure you only add a dash of Auburn.



#### DARK BROWN (90%) + BLACK (10%)

For clients that wish for a strong, bold and dark brow, you can use Dark Brown with a dash of Black. This creates a beautiful dark look without overdoing it by going too intense.



#### **MEDIUM BROWN (90%) + BLACK (10%)**

For clients that do not have naturally dark features, but still love an intense brow look. The combo of Medium Brown with a dash of Black will provide the bold results without being too intense in color. At first it sounds like it may be a bit too heavy, but it creates a beautiful defined brow. However, do not process the henna too long, it can easily stain too dark. It's easier to shorten the process time, and re apply if it's still too light.
