



Aberdeen

A quick cabled toque knit in the round from brim to top in bulky yarn.

Yarn: 1 skein of Illimani Llama II (100% Baby Llama; 109 yds per 100g). *Shown in Pale Pink.*

Needles: 6.0mm/US10 40cm/16" circular AND set of 4 double pointed needles

Gauge: 17 sts = 4"/10cm in pattern

Other tools: stitch marker, darning needle, cable needle.

Body

CO 72sts on circular needle. Join in the round, being careful not to twist. Place marker at the beginning of round.

(K2, P2) around for 7 rounds.

K around for 2 rounds.

Rnd 1: [K3, C3F] around

Rnd 2-6: K

Rnd 7: [C3B, K3] around

Rnd 8-12: K

Repeat rounds 1-12 twice more

Top

Switch to double pointed needles when needed

Rnd 1: [K1, K2tog, C3F] around (64sts)

Rnd 2: [K2tog, K6] around (56 sts)

Rnd 3: [K2, K2tog, K3] around (48sts)

Rnd 4: [K1, K2tog, K3] around (40sts)

Rnd 5: [K2tog, K3] around (32sts)

Rnd 6: [K2, K2tog] around (24sts)

Rnd 7: [K1, K2tog] around (16sts)

Rnd 8: [K2tog] around (8sts)

Break yarn, pull through remaining sts and pull tight. Weave in all ends and block.

Abbreviations:

K – knit

P – purl

K2tog – knit 2 together

rep – repeat

rnd – round

CO – cast on

St(s) – stitch(es)

C3F – put 3 sts on cable needle and hold in front, K 3 sts from left needle, K 3 sts from cable needle.

C3B – put 3 sts on cable needle and hold in back, K 3 sts from left needle, K 3 sts from cable needle.
