

A squashy, cabled toque with a folded brim for extra warmth.

Yarn: 1 skein of Berroco Ultra Alpaca (50\% Alpaca, 50\% Wool; 215yds/100g); Shown in 6209 Moonshadow.

Needles: $4.0 \mathrm{~mm} /$ US6 $16^{\prime \prime}$ circular needles
$4.5 \mathrm{~mm} /$ US7 $16^{\prime \prime}$ circular needles and set of 4 double pointed needles. (or longer circulars for magic loop)

Gauge: 20sts $=4 \prime / 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ in stockinette
Other tools: stitch marker, cable needle, darning needle, pompom

## BRIM

With smaller needles, CO 104 sts, join in the round and place marker.
(K2, P2) around for 6 ".
(K2, P2) around for one more round, increasing 4 sts
evenly around. (108sts)
Switch to larger needles

## Bogy

Cable pattern is worked over 27sts, and is both shown in the chart and written out below. Pattern is repeated 4 times per round.

Set-Up Round (0): K9, P7, K4, P7
Round 1: 3/3RC, K3, P7, 2/2LC, P7
Round 2: K9, P7, K4, P7
Round 3: K9, P6, 1/2RPC, 2/1LC, P6
Round 4: K9, P6, K2, (K1, P1), K2, P6
Round 5: K3, 3/3LC, P5, 1/2RC, (P1, K1), 2/1LPC, P5
Round 6: K9, P5, K2, (P1, K1) twice, K2, P5
Round 7: K9, P4, 1/2RPC, (K1, P1) twice, 2/1LC, P4
Round 8: K9, P4, K2, (K1, P1) three times, K2, P4
Round 9: 3/3RC, K3, P3, 1/2RC, (P1, K1) three times, 2/1LPC, P3

Round 10: K9, P3, K2, (P1, K1) four times, K2, P3
Round 11: K9, P2, 1/2RPC, (K1, P1) four times, 2/1LC, P2
Round 12: K9, P2, K2, (K1, P1) five times, K2, P2

Round 13: K3, 3/3LC, P2, 2/1LPC, (K1, P1) four times, 1/2RPC, P2

Round 14: K9, P3, K2, (P1, K1) four times, K2, P3
Round 15: K9, P3, 2/1LPC, (P1, K1) three times, 1/2RPC, P3

Round 16: K9, P4, K2, (K1, P1) three times, K2, P4
Round 17: 3/3RC, K3, P4, 2/1LPC, (K1, P1) twice, 1/2RPC, P4

Round 18: K9, P5, K2, (P1, K1) twice, K2, P5
Round 19: K9, P5, 2/1LPC, (P1, K1), 1/2RPC, P5
Round 20: K9, P6, K2, (K1, P1), K2, P6
Round 21: K3, 3/3LC, P6, 2/1LPC, 1/2RPC, P6
Round 22: K9, P7, K4, P7
Round 23: K9, P7, 2/2LC, P7
Round 24: K9, P7, K4, P7
Round 25: 3/3RC, K3, P6, 1/2RPC, 2/1LC, P6
Round 26: K9, P6, K2, (K1, P1), K2, P6
Round 27: K9, P5, 1/2RC, (P1, K1), 2/1LPC, P5
Round 28: K9, P5, K2, (P1, K1) twice, K2, P5
Round 29: K3, 3/3LC, P4, 1/2RPC, (K1, P1) twice, 2/1LC, P4

Round 30: K9, P4, K2, (K1, P1) three times, K2, P4
Round 31: K9, P3, 1/2RC, (P1, K1) three times, 2/1LPC, P3

Round 32: K9, P3, K2, (P1, K1) four times, K2, P3
From here, even-numbered rows are decreasing rows. The decreases are worked in with the pattern. At the end of each odd-numbered row, work until 1 st from the end of round, then move the last st to the beginning of the next round; it will be consumed with the next K2tog.

Round 33: 3/3RC, K3, P2, 1/2RPC, (K1, P1) four times, 2/1LC, P2. (repeat pattern to last st of round, move last st to beg of next round).
Round 34: K2tog, K3, K2tog, K2, SSK, P1, K2, (K1, P1) five times, K2, P1. (96sts)

Round 35: K8, P1, 2/1LPC, (K1, P1) four times, 1/2RPC, P1. (move last st to beg of next round)
Round 36: K2tog, K4, K2tog, SSK, P1, K2, (P1, K1) four times, K2, P1. (84sts)

## Abbreviations:

CO: Cast On
Sts(s): stitch(es)
CN: Cable Needle
SI: Slip st
K: Knit
P: Purl
K2tog: Knit 2 together
SSK: Slip 2 sts knitwise, insert left needle into the front of both slipped sts, knit 2 together through back of loops.
1/2RC: Slip 1 st on CN and hold in back of work, K2, then K1 from CN.
2/1LC: Slip 2 sts on CN and hold in front of work, k1, then k2 from CN.

1/2RPC: Slip 1 st on CN and hold in back of work, K2, then P1 from CN.
2/1LPC: Slip 2 sts on CN and hold in front of work, P1, then K2 from CN.
2/2RC: Slip 2 sts on CN and hold in back of work, K2, then K2 from CN.
2/2LC: Slip 2 sts on CN and hold in front of work, K2, then K2 from CN.
3/3RC: Slip 3 sts on CN and hold in back of work, K3, then K3 from CN.
3/3LC: Slip 3 sts on CN and hold in front of work, K3, then K3 from CN.

Round 37: K3, 2/2LC, P1, 2/1LPC, (P1, K1) three times, $1 / 2 R P C, ~ P 1$. (move last st to beg of next round)

Round 38: K2tog, SSK, K3, SSK, P1, K2, (K1, P1) three times, K2, P1. (72sts)

Round 39: K6, P1, 2/1LPC, (K1, P1) twice, 1/2RPC, P1. (move last st to beg of next round)

Round 40: K2tog, K2, (SSK) twice, P1, K2, (P1, K1) twice, K2, P1. (60sts)

Round 41: 2/2RC, K1, P1, 2/1LPC, (P1, K1), 1/2RPC, P1. (move last st to beg of next round)

Round 42: K2tog, K1, (SSK) twice, P1, K2, (K1, P1), K2, P1. (48sts)

Round 43: K4, P1, 2/1LPC, 1/2RPC, P1. (move last st to beg of next round)

Round 44: K2tog, (SSK) twice, P1, K4, P1 (36sts)
Round 45: K1, SSK, P1, (SI1, put one st on CN in front, SI1 back from R to L, SSK, put cable st on L needle, SSK), P1. (move last st to beg of next round). (24sts)

Round 46: K2tog, SSK, SSK. (12sts)
Round 47: K2tog around (6sts) (Not Shown in Chart)
Break yarn and draw through remaining sts. Pull tight and weave in ends. Wet block, and attach pompom when dry.
