

A simple and stylish striped scarf.

Yarn: Berroco Vintage (52% Acrylic, 40% Wool, 8% Nylon; 218 yds per 100g); 1 skein each of two colours. Shown in 5107 Cracked Pepper (C1) and 5145 Cast Iron (C2)

Needles: 5.0mm (US8) straight or circular needles.

Gauge: 18 sts = 4''/10 cm in stockinette

30 sts = 4"/10cm in unstretched ribbing

Other tools: darning needle.

Finished Measurements: 7" x 56"

With C1, CO 40 sts.

Working 2 rows of C1, then 2 rows of C2, K1 P1 every row. Do not break yarn in-between stripes but allow the unused yarn to float up the side of the work until it is needed again.

Continue in this manner until the scarf is desired length or yarn is used up.

Bind off in rib.

Abbreviations:

K – knit

P – purl

CO – cast on

St(s) – stitch(es)

C1/C2 – colour 1/2
