



This simplest of cowls to show off a patterned yarn.

Yarn: Katia Concept Air Alpaca Natural (60% Alpaca, 17% Cotton, 13% Nylon, 10% Wool; 147yds per 50g);

- 2 balls of Main Colour (*shown in 200*)
- 1 ball of Contrast Colour (*shown in 105*)

Needles: 6.0mm/US10 16"/40cm circular needle

Gauge: 12sts per 4" in ribbing pattern, after blocking.

Finished Measurements: 11" wide x 20" tall

Other tools: stitch marker, darning needle.

Using Contrast Colour, loosely cast on 64 sts and join in the round.

[K 1 round, P1 round] twice.

*Change to Main Colour and K for 6".

Change to Contrast Colour, [K 1 round, P 1 round] three times.

Repeat from * twice more.

On the last round of the last repeat, Bind Off purlwise.

Abbreviations:

K – knit

P – purl

St(s) – stitch(es)
