



# ELGIN

A simple triangular shawl, worked in stockinette from the centre out. This is more of a method than a pattern. It can be applied to any weight or style of yarn and is easily adapted to size and yardage.

**Yarn:** (Shown) Katia Concept Soft Lino (100% Linen; 820 yards per 150g), Colour 607: 1 ball.

**Needles:** 3.25mm/US3 circular needle, 32" or longer.  
*Choose a needle size to create a relaxed gauge for your yarn*

**Gauge:** 19 sts = 4"/10cm in stockinette stitch. *Gauge is not critical for this project.*

**Finished Measurements:** 80" X 40", after blocking.

CO 5 sts.

Set Up A (RS): K2, YO, K1, YO, K2. (7 sts)

Set Up B (WS): K2, P3, K2.

Set Up C: K2, YO, K1, YO, pm, K1, YO, K1, YO, K2. (11 sts)

Set Up D: K2, P to last 2 sts, slipping m as you go, K2.

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, YO, K to m, YO, sm, K1, YO, K to last 2 sts, YO, K2. (4 sts inc)

**Row 2 (WS):** K2, P to last 2 sts (slipping m as you go), K2

Repeat **Rows 1** and **2** until shawl is desired size, making sure there is enough yarn remaining for at least 6 more rows, **and** that the number of stitches on the right side of the marker (when facing RS) is a multiple of 3 + 2 sts.

Eyelet Row (RS): K2, YO, \*K1, K2tog, DYO, rep from \* to m, sm, K1, \*DYO, K1, K2tog, rep from \* to last 2 sts, YO, K2.

Next (WS): K2, P to last 2 sts (dropping DYO back into single stitches – see note in abbreviations)

Next (RS): as **Row 1**

Next (WS): K all sts.

Next (RS): as **Row 1**.

Bind off very loosely, using needle at least 1.0mm larger. Weave in ends and wet block.

## Abbreviations:

K – knit

P – purl

K2tog – knit 2 together

YO – yarn over

sm/pm – slip marker / place marker

DYO – double yarn over  
*(when purling into this on the following WS row, work only once, into the first loop, allowing the other yarn over loop to fall away).*

CO – cast on

St(s) – stitch(es)
