



# FRASER

A quick toque knit in the round from brim to top, made extra soft by holding an air-spun aran weight yarn double with a fine fluffy yarn.

This hat will fit most adult heads, but can be adjusted by adding or subtracting stitches in groups of seven, which will add/subtract about 2" to the hat circumference.

**Yarn:** Katia Concept Cotton Merino (70% Cotton, 30% Wool; 115 yds per 50g), 1 ball. *Shown in 103 Pale Pink*  
Berroco Andean Mist (74% Baby Suri Alpaca, 26% Mulberry Silk; 164 yds per 25g), 1 ball. *Shown in 6326 Lagoon.* **OR** Rico Essentials Super Kid Mohair Silk (70% Mohair, 30% Silk; 220yds per 25g), 1 ball.

**Needles:** 5.5mm/US9 40cm/16" circular AND set of 4 double pointed needles

**Gauge:** 14 sts = 4"/10cm in stocking stitch

**Other tools:** stitch marker, darning needle.

## Body

Holding both yarns double, CO 70 sts on circular needle. Join in the round & place marker at beginning of round.

(K1tbl, P1) around until work measures 3" from edge.

K all sts until work measures 6 ½" from edge.

## Top

*Switch to double pointed needles when needed.*

Rnd 1: \*K5, K2tog, rep from \* to end of round. (60 sts)

Rnd 2 & 3: K all sts.

Rnd 4: \*K4, K2tog, rep from \* to end of round. (50 sts)

Rnd 5: K all sts.

Rnd 6: \*K3, K2tog, rep from \* to end of round. (40 sts)

Rnd 7: K all sts.

Rnd 8: \*K2, K2tog, rep from \* to end of round. (30 sts)

Rnd 9: \*K1, K2tog, rep from \* to end of round. (20 sts)

Rnd 10: K2tog around. (10 sts)

Break yarn, pull through remaining sts and pull tight. Weave in all ends and block.

### Abbreviations:

K – knit  
P – purl  
K1tbl – Knit 1 through back of loop  
K2tog – knit 2 together  
rep – repeat  
rnd – round  
CO – cast on  
St(s) – stitch(es)
