



HOUSE SCARF

This scarf is worked as a tube, then pressed flat and seamed at both ends by attaching tassels. The finished dimensions are 7"x80" (including tassel).

Yarn: 400yds *each* of two colours of worsted weight yarn. Shown above in Berroco Vintage, 5134 Crimson and 5121 Sunny

Needles: 5.0mm (US8) 16" (40cm) circular needle (or a longer circular for magic loop).

Gauge: 19 st = 4"/10cm

Other tools: stitch marker, darning needle, crochet hook.

With C1, CO 68 sts and join in the round, being careful not to twist. Place marker at beginning of round.

K 22 rounds.

Cut yarn and K one round with C2.

For jogless stripes, slip the first st of the second round with the new colour.

K 22 rounds total in C2.

Switch back to C1 and repeat instructions for making a jogless stripe.

Knit a total of 19 stipes (10 C1 and 9 C2). BO all sts. Weave in ends.

Lay scarf flat. Cut yarn to 10" lengths for tassels (*wrapping yarn around a DVD case and cutting along one side works well*).

Use 3 strings of the same colour bundled together. Fold the bundle in half and, using a crochet hook, poke the folded end through both sides of the edge of the flat scarf. Pull cut ends through the loop created by the fold. Pull tight.

Repeat with bundles of alternating colours along both ends of the scarf.

Abbreviations:

K – knit

CO – cast on

St(s) – stitch(es)

BO – bind off

C1/C2 – colour 1/2
