

A modern, fingering-weight toque with a triple-thick brim.

This pattern includes instructions for four sizes and should fit snuggly with 2-3" of negative ease.

Sizes: Baby (Child, Adult S, Adult L)
Finished Circumference: 14.5" (16", 18", 20")

Yarn: Sandnes Garn Sisu (80% superwash wool, 20% nylon; 190 yards per 50g);

2 (2, 2, 3) balls.

**Needles:** 2.75mm (US2) 16" circular and set of double pointed needles (or longer circular for magic loop)

**Gauge:** 28 sts = 4"/10cm in stockinette

Other tools: stitch markers, darning needle.

## BRIM

Using circular needles, CO 102 (114, 126, 138) sts. Join in the round and be careful not to twist. Place marker at BOR.

K in the round until work measures 5 (6, 7, 8)" from cast on edge.

Turn work inside out and continue knitting in the round (this will be in the opposite direction than before). Continue until work measures 6 (6.5, 7.5, 8.5)" from turning point.

## TOP

Switch to DPNs when needed.

Set Up Round: \*K17 (19, 21, 23), pm, rep from \* a total five times, K to end of round. (6 markers in total, including BOR marker).

Decreasing Round: \*K2tog, K to 2 sts before m, SSK, sm, rep from \* a total of six times. (12 sts decreased).

K one round.

Work Decreasing Round and one round of plain knitting again.

Work Decreasing Round every round until 18 sts remain.

K2tog around, removing markers as you go. (9 sts).

Break yarn, pull tail through remaining stitches and pull tight.

## FINISHING

Fold up bottom edge (purl-sides together) so that the cast on edge is  $\frac{3}{4}$ "/2cm below the change from purling to knitting.

Gently stitch the cast on edge to the hat using a whip stitch. (See photo below).

Fold the folded section up at the seam to create a triple fold, with all purl-sides hidden.

Weave in all ends, wet-block and enjoy!



The hat after the first folding and seaming. The lower band will be folded up once more

## Abbreviations:

K – knit

pm – place marker

sm – slip marker

K2tog - knit 2 together

SSK – slip 2 sts knitwise, move both to left needle and K 2 together through back of loop

CO – cast on

St(s) - stitch(es)

BOR – beginning of round
