



Simple worsted-weight gauntlets with a gusseted thumb. Left and right arms are worked the same.

**Yarn:** Urth Uneek Worsted (100% Superwash Merino Wool; 220yds per 100g). *Shown in Harmony.*

**Needles:** 4.5mm (US7) DPNs/9" Circular/Magic Loop

**Gauge:** 20 sts = 4"/10cm in stockinette

**Other tools:** stitch markers, darning needle

## CUFF

CO 40 sts, join in the round. Work K2, P2 ribbing for 10.5"

## THUMB GUSSET

Set Up Round: K2, pm, K1, pm, K to end of rnd.

Round 1: K to marker, sm, m1L, K to marker, m1R, sm, K to end of round.

Rounds 2 and 3: K (slipping markers as you go).

Repeat Rounds 1-3 three more times.

## THUMB RIBBING:

Round 1: K to marker, sm, m1L, \*P1, K1, rep from \* until 1 st before marker, P1, m1R, sm, K to end of round.

Round 2: K to marker, sm, \*K1, P1, rep from \* to 1 st before marker, K1, sm, K to end of round.

Repeat Round 2 only another two more times.

## CAST OFF THUMB:

K2, BO next 11 sts, K to end of round. *(remove markers)*

Next Round: K2, CO 3 sts with backwards loop, rejoin to other side of thumb gusset and K to end of round.

K 1 round.

Next Round: K2, slip 1 knitwise, K2tog, pass slipped stitch over, K to end of round. *(40 sts)*.

K another 8 rounds, then work K2, P2 ribbing for four rounds.

BO all sts in ribbing.

### Abbreviations:

K – knit  
 P – purl  
 pm – place marker  
 sm – slip marker  
 m1L – make 1 st, left leaning  
 m1R – make 1 st, right leaning  
 K2tog – knit 2 together  
 CO – cast on  
 St(s) – stitch(es)
