



A striped triangular shawl worked out from the tip. This shawl is designed to use two skeins of fingering weight yarn; one for the garter stitch sections and one for the simple repeating lace pattern.

Yarn: Manos del Uruguay Alegria (75% superwash merino wool, 25% nylon; 448yds per 100g), **2 skeins.**

Colour A works garter stitch sections, Colour B works lace pattern sections.

Shown in Genghis Kahn (Colour A) and Oxygen (Colour B).

Needles: 3.5mm/US4 circular needle, 32" or longer.

Gauge: 19 sts = 4"/10cm in stockinette/garter stitch

Finished Measurements: 104" wingspan X 21" maximum depth, after blocking.

Other tools: darning needle.

GARTER PATTERN

Row A (RS): K1, K2tog, K to last 3 sts, Kfbf, dr, K1.

Row B (WS): K1, YO, K to end of row.

LACE PATTERN

**** NOTE:** When knitting into the double yarn over (DYO) on the WS row, knit only once (into the first loop) allowing the other yarn over loop to fall away. This will turn the double YO back into 1 st. ******

Row 1 (RS): K1, K2tog, *K1, K2tog, DYO, rep from * to last 3 sts, Kfbf, dr, K1.

Row 2, and all even numbered rows (WS): K1, YO, K to end of row.

Row 3 (RS): K1, K2tog, *K1, K2tog, DYO, rep from * to last 4 sts, K1, Kfbf, dr, K1.

Row 5 (RS): K1, K2tog, K1, *K1, K2tog, DYO, rep from * to last 4 sts, K1, Kfbf, dr, K1.

Row 7 (RS): K1, K2tog, K1, *K1, K2tog, DYO, rep from * to last 5 sts, K2, Kfbf, dr, K1.

Row 9 (RS): K1, K2tog, K2tog, DYO, *K1, K2tog, DYO, rep from * to last 5 sts, K2, Kfbf, dr, K1.

Row 11 (RS): K1, K2tog, K2tog, DYO, *K1, K2tog, DYO, rep from * to last 3 sts, Kfbf, dr, K1.

SECTION 1

With Colour A: CO 6 sts

Set Up Row (WS): K1, YO, K to end of row. (7sts)

Work Rows A and B of **Garter Pattern** 2 times total. (9 sts)

SECTION 2

With Colour B:

Row 1 (RS): K1, K2tog, K1, K2tog, DYO, Kfbf, dr, K1.

Row 2 (WS) **See NOTE in **Lace Pattern** instructions**:
K1, YO, K to end of row.

Row 3 (RS): K1, K2tog, K1, K2tog, DYO, K1, Kfbf, dr, K1.

Row 4 (WS) K1, YO, K to end of row. (11 sts).

SECTION 3

With Colour A:

Work Rows A and B of **Garter Pattern** 3 times total. (14 sts).

SECTION 4

With Colour B:

Work **Rows 5-12** of **Lace Pattern**. (18 sts)

SECTION 5

With Colour A:

Work Rows A and B of **Garter Pattern** 5 times total. (23 sts).

SECTION 6

With Colour B:

Work **Rows 5-12** of **Lace Pattern**

Work **Rows 1-4** of **Lace Pattern**. (29 sts).

SECTION 7

With Colour A:

Work Rows A and B of **Garter Pattern** 7 times total (36 sts).

SECTION 8

With Colour B:

Work **Rows 1-12** of **Lace Pattern**

Work **Rows 1-4** of **Lace Pattern** (44 sts)

SECTION 9

With Colour A:

Work Rows A and B of **Garter Pattern** 9 times total. (53 sts).

SECTION 10

With Colour B:

Work **Rows 5-12** of **Lace Pattern**

Work **Rows 1-12** of **Lace Pattern**. (63 sts)

SECTION 11

With Colour A:

Work Rows A and B of **Garter Pattern** 11 times total. (74 sts).

SECTION 12

With Colour B:

Work **Rows 5-12** of **Lace Pattern**

Work **Rows 1-12** of **Lace Pattern**

Work **Rows 1-4** of **Lace Pattern** (86 sts)

SECTION 13

With Colour A:

Work Rows A and B of **Garter Pattern** 13 times. (99 sts).

SECTION 14

With Colour B:

Work **Rows 1-12** of **Lace Pattern** twice

Work **Rows 1-4** of **Lace Pattern** (113 sts)

SECTION 15

With Colour A:

Work Rows A and B of **Garter Pattern** 15 times. (128 sts).

SECTION 16

With *Colour B*:

Work **Rows 5-12** of **Lace Pattern**

Work **Rows 1-12** of **Lace Pattern** twice (144 sts)

SECTION 17

With *Colour A*:

Work Rows A and B of **Garter Pattern** 17 times total.
(161 sts).

SECTION 18

With *Colour B*:

Work **Rows 5-12** of **Lace Pattern**

Work **Rows 1-12** of **Lace Pattern** twice

Work **Rows 1-4** of **Lace Pattern** (179 sts)

SECTION 19

With *Colour A*:

Work Rows A and B of **Garter Pattern** 19 times total.
(198 sts).

Bind off with Stretchy Bind Off: K1, *K1, insert left needle into the front of both sts on the right needle, K2tog, rep from * until all sts are cast off.

Break yarn and pull through last stitch. Weave in all ends and wet block to desired size.

Abbreviations:

K – knit

K2tog – knit 2 together

Kfbf – knit into the front, then the back, then the front again of the same st:
3 sts made from 1.

YO – yarn over

DYO – double yarn over (when knitting into this on the following WS row, knit only once, into the first loop, allowing the other yarn over loop to fall away).

dr – drop yarn over

CO – cast on

St(s) – stitch(es)
