#### Yarn

West Yorkshire Spinners - Retreat Chunky Roving



A – Adore (552)

6 x 100g



**B - Pure (010)** 4 x 100g

#### Measurements

Width x Length (for finished Blanket)

#### Equipment

7mm (UK 2) crochet hook.

Darning needle

Scissors

#### **Tension**

12.5 sts and 11 rows to 10cm (4in) measured over wrong side of overlay mosaic pattern using 7mm hook or size required to achieve correct tension. It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure success.

#### Pattern notes

This pattern is written using UK terminology with US conversions given in brackets in abbreviation list.

This crochet blanket uses the Overlay Mosaic Crochet technique. In this technique you only work with the right side facing you, working each row once only. This requires you to cut and join in new yarn on every row. Start a new row with standing double crochet. We will add edging at the end to hide all the ends.

The first 2 and last 2 sts are always worked in double crochet and indicate the colour you will use for the whole row.

Work each st in back loop only (BLO), and place trebles (FLtr2d) when required, working trebles into front loops of stitches from first row below of the same colour.

This pattern is charted and written. However, many will find working from the chart is the easiest method.

htr (US hdc) half treble crochet (US half double crochet)

tr (US dc) treble (US double crochet)

**WS** wrong side


#### **Special Abbreviations**

Standing dc

Beginning with a slip knot on hook, hold in place, work double crochet into stitch.

Chainless foundation double (US single) crochet. Start with ch2, insert hook into bump of 2<sup>nd</sup> st from hook, yrh pull through a loop, yrh pull through one loop, yrh and pull through both loops on hook (this is your 1<sup>st</sup> dc). For remaining sts: (insert hook into ch st, pull through a loop, yrh and pull through one loop, yrh and pull through both loops on hook), rep to end.







## **Chart Notes**

The chart is read from right to left on every row.

Each row is worked using the colour indicated at the beginning of the row. The 1st row is worked in chainless double crochet foundation.

Standing dc

The colours on the chart show a visual representation of the finished pattern when the FLtr2d stitches have been made. The Stitch Key shows you what stitch to make across the row in whichever colour you are using, despite the colour shown on the chart.

Start with a standing dc in the 1st st, 1dc, work dc BLO in any following stitch without F, work Fltr2d in stitches with F, and end with 1dc in each of the last 2 stitches.



#### Written Pattern - Christmas Pines

#### Pattern Note - All rows are RS rows.

Row 1 (RS): Using A, make 87dc using chainless foundation.

**Row 2: Using B,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc in next st, 1dc in BLO in every st to last 2 sts, 1dc in last 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 3: Using A, as row 2. Fasten off.

Row 4: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, \*1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1Fltr2d, 1dc BLO, 1Fltr2d, rep from \* to last 5 sts, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 5: Using A,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, \*2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 6: Using B,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, \*1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 7: Using A,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2dc BLO, \*(1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO) twice, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 8: Using B,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, \*2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 9: Using A,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2dc BLO, \*1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 10: Using B,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, \*(1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO) twice, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 11: Using A,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, \*2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 12: Using B,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, \*1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 13: Using A, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2dc BLO, \*(1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO) twice, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 14: Using B, standing dc in first st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, \*1dc BLO, (2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 15: Using A, as row 2. Fasten off.

Row 16: Using B, as row 2. Fasten off.

**Row 17: Using A,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc \*1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 18: Using B, as row 2. Fasten off.

Row 19: Using A, as row 2. Fasten off.

Row 20: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 1FLtr2d, (1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d) 4 times, 2dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) 4 times, \*1FLtr2d, (1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d) 5 times, 2dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) 4 times, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 21: Using A, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 9dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 8dc BLO, \*11dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 8dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 22: Using B,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 1FLtr2d, 18dc BLO, \*1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 18dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1Fltr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 23: Using A, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 3dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) 3 times, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) 3 times,

1dc BLO, \*5dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) 3 times, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) 3 times, 1dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 24: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, 16dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, \*1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 16dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 25: Using A, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 4dc BLO, (1FLtr2dc, 1dc BLO) twice, 4FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, 2dc BLO, \*6dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, 4FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, 2dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 26: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 3FLtr2d, 14dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, \*1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, 14dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 27: Using A, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 5dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, 3dc BLO, \*7dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, 3dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 28: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 12dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, \*(1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, 2FLtr2d, 12dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 29: Using A, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 6dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 4FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 5dc BLO, \*8dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 4FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 5dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 30: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 10dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, \*1FLtr2d, (1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d) twice, 10dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 31: Using A, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 7dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 6dc BLO, \*9dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 6dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 32: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, (1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d) twice, 8dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, \*1Fltr2dc, 1dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 8dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 33: Using A,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 8dc BLO, 4FLtr2d, 7dc BLO, \*10dc BLO, 4FLtr2d, 7dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 34: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, (2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, 5dc BLO, (2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, \*(1FLtrd, 1dc BLO) twice, (2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, 5dc BLO, (2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.


Row 35: Using A, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 9dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 8dc BLO, \*11dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 8dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.


Row 36: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, (2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) 3 times, 3dc BLO, (2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, 1FLtr2d, \*1FLtr2d, (1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d) 3 times, 4dc BLO, (2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 37: Using A,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 9dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 8dc BLO, \*11dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 8dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 38: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, (1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d) 3 times, 2dc BLO, (2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, 2FLtr2d, \*1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, (1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d) twice, 2dc BLO, (2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, 2FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

Rows 39-41: As rows 15-17. Fasten off.





#### Written pattern - Reindeer Rides

**Pattern Note** – All rows are **RS** rows. Continue from row 41 of Part 1 – Christmas Pines.

**Row 1 (RS): Using B**, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 1dc in BLO in every st to last 2 sts, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 2: Using A, as row 1. Fasten off.

Row 3: Using B, as row 1. Fasten off.

**Row 4: Using A,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, \*2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 5: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2dc BLO, \*2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 6: Using A**, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, \*1FLtr2d, 3dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 5dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 7: Using B,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2dc BLO, \*1dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 8: Using A,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, \*5dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 3dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 9: Using B,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2dc BLO, \*2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 10: Using A,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, \*2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 11: Using B, as row 1. Fasten off.

Row 12: Using A, as row 1. Fasten off.

Row 13: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 3FLtr2d, \*(1dc BLO, 4FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, (3FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, 4FLtr2d) twice, 1dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 2 sts, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 14: Using A,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 3dc BLO, \*1FLtr2d, 3dc BLO, rep from \* to last 2 sts, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 15: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 3FLtr2d, \*2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, (4FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, 4FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, 3FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 2 sts, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 16: Using A, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 3dc BLO, \*1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 11dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 9dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 11dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 4dc BLO, rep from \* to last 2 sts, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 17: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, \*1FLtr2d, 4dc BLO, 4FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, (3FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, 1dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 4FLtr2d, 4dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 2 sts, 2dc. Fasten off

Row 18: Using A, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2dc BLO, \*4dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 9dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 7dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 9dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 5dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 19: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, \*3FLtr2d, 12dc BLO, (3FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, 11dc BLO, 3FLtr2d\*, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, rep from \* to \* to last 5 sts, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 20: Using A, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 3dc BLO, \*3dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, (1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d) twice, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 11dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, (1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d) twice, 1dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, 6dc BLO, rep from \* to last 2 sts, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 21: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 3FLtr2d, \*1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 10dc BLO, (3FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) 3 times, 9dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to \* to last 5 sts, 3FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 22: Using A, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 3dc BLO, \*3dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, (1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d) 4 times, 11dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) 4 times, 2FLtr2d, 6dc BLO, rep from \* to last 2 sts, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 23: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, \*2FLtr2d, 11dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, (1dc BLO, 3FLtr2d) twice, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 11dc BLO, 2FLtr2d\*, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, rep from \* to \* to last 5 sts, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 24: Using A, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 3dc BLO, \*2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 8dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 11dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 8dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 5dc BLO, rep from \* to last 2 sts, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 25: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 3FLtr2d, \*1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, 5FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 5FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, \*1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, FLtr2d, rep from \* to \* to last 5 sts, 3FLtr2d, 2dc. Row 27: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, \*3FLtr2d, (1dc BLO, 3FLtr2d) twice, 5dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 5dc BLO, (3FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, 3FLtr2d\*, 1fLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to \* to last 5 sts, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 28: Using A, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 3dc BLO, \*11dc BLO, (2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, 3dc BLO, (1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d) twice, 14dc BLO, rep from \* to last 2 sts, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 29: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 3FLtr2d, \*1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 9dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 9dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d\*, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to \* to last 5 sts, 3FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 31: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, \*3FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 3dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 5FLtr2d, 3dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 3dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 3FLtr2d\*, 3dc BLO, rep from \* to \* to last 5 sts, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 32: Using A, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 3dc BLO, \*6dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 4dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 5dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, 5dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 4dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 6dc BLO\*, 3FLtr2d, rep from \* to \* to last 5 sts, 3dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 33: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 4FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, \*4FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 3dc BLO, 4FLtr2d, 5dc BLO, 4FLtr2d, 3dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 4FLtr2d\*, 1FLtr2d, 5dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to \* to last 7 sts, 1dc BLO, 4FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 34: Using A, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 5dc BLO, \*9dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 4dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 4dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 9dc BLO\*, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, rep from \* to \* to last 7 sts, 5dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 35: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, \*1FLtr2d, (1dc BLO, 3FLtr2d) twice, 1dc BLO, 4FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, 4FLtr2d, (1dc BLO, 3FLtr2d) twice, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d\*, (1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO) twice, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to \* to last 7 sts, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Rows 36-44: Rep rows 2-10. Fasten off.

The colours on the chart show a visual representation of the finished pattern when the FLtr2d stitches have been made. The Stitch Key shows you what stitch to make across the row in whichever colour you are using, despite the colour shown on the chart.

Start with a standing dc in the first st, 1dc, work dc BLO in any following stitch without F, work Fltr2d in stitches with F, and end with 1dc in each of the last two stitches.



#### Written pattern - Falling Snow

**Pattern Note** – All rows are **RS** rows. Continue from row 44 of Part 2 – Reindeer Rides.

**Row 1 (RS): Using B,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 1dc in BLO in every st to last 2 sts, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 2: Using A, as row 1. Fasten off.

Row 3: Using B, as row 1. Fasten off.

Row 4: Using A, as row 1. Fasten off.

Row 5: Using B, as row 1. Fasten off.

**Row 6: Using A,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, \*1dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, 3dc BLO, 5FLtr2d, 3dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 7: Using B,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2dc BLO, \*4dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 5dc BLO) twice, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 8: Using A, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, \*2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 5dc BLO) twice, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 9: Using B,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2dc BLO, \*6dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) 4 times, 6dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 10: Using A, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, \*3dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, (3dc BLO, 1FLtr2d) twice, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 3dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 11: Using B,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2dc BLO, \*(1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 5dc BLO) twice, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 12: Using A,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, \*5dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) 5 times, 4dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 13: Using B,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2dc BLO, \*2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 9dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 3dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 14: Using A, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, \*2FLtr2d, 5dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) 3 times, 4dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 15: Using B,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 1dc in BLO in every st to last 2 sts, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 16: Using A, as row 14. Fasten off.

**Row 17: Using B,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2dc BLO, \*2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 9dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 3dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 18: Using A,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, \*5dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) 5 times, 4dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 19: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2dc BLO, \*(1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 5dc BLO) twice, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 20: Using A, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, \*3dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, (3dc BLO, 1FLtr2d) twice, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 3dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 21: Using B,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2dc BLO, \*6dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) 4 times, 6dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 22: Using A,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, \*2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 5dc BLO) twice, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 23: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2dc BLO, \*4dc BLO, (1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 5dc BLO) twice, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 24: Using A,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, \*1dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, 3dc BLO, 5FLtr2d, 3dc BLO, 3FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 25: Using B, as row 1. Fasten off.

Row 26: Using A, as row 1. Fasten off.

Row 27: Using B, as row 1. Fasten off.

Row 28: Using A, as row 1. Fasten off.

Row 29: Using B, as row 1. Fasten off.

Row 30: Using A, as row 1. Fasten off.

**Row 31: Using B,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, \*2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 32: Using A,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, \*2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 33: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, \*1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 34: Using A, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2dc BLO, \*(1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO) twice, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 35: Using B,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, \*2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 36: Using A,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2dc BLO, \*1dc BLO, 1FLtr2dc, 2dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 37: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, \*(1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO) twice, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.


Row 38: Using A, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, \*2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 39: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, \*1dc BLO, 1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

**Row 40: Using A,** standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2dc BLO, \*(1FLtr2d, 2dc BLO) twice, 1FLtr2d, 1dc BLO, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1dc BLO, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 41: Using B, standing dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 1dc, 2FLtr2d, \*1dc BLO, (2FLtr2d, 1dc BLO) twice, 1FLtr2d, rep from \* to last 3 sts, 1FLtr2d, 2dc. Fasten off.

Row 42: Using A, as row 1. Fasten off.



#### Written Pattern - Wrapping up

**Note** – In this final part of the Lapland CAL, we will be making the edging to hide all the tails. This will be a double-sided edging, which will enclose all ends.

Before starting the edging, all the ends of yarn need to be tidied. To do this, tie the ends in pairs with double knots, (this will ensure the ends will not unravel) and then trim them to about 2.5cm.

#### **Back Edging**

**Foundation rnd:** With **WS** of blanket facing and **A**, starting from the top left corner, work 1 standing dc in between the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> st from the edge, working around the strands between of the 3<sup>rd</sup> row from the top.

Now, work 1dc in every row in between the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> st from the edge, until you have 2 rows left (123dc), 2ch (corner ch-2sp made), turn to work along foundation, miss 1<sup>st</sup> 2 sts, 1dc into front loop of every st of chainless foundation to last 2 sts, miss last 2 sts. 83dc.

Working down the right side, miss next 2 rows, 2ch (corner ch-2sp made), 1dc in every row to last 2, placing dc in between  $2^{nd}$  and  $3^{rd}$  st from the right edge. 123dc.

2ch (corner ch-2sp made), miss first 2 sts, 1dc into the front loop of every st of top edge to last 2 sts, miss 2 sts, 2ch (corner ch-2sp made), sl-st to first dc.

83dc. (412dc in total and 4 ch-2sps)

Rnd 1: 1ch (does not counts as a st here and throughout), \*1dc in every st to next ch-2sp, (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) in next ch-2sp, rep from \* to end, sl-st to first dc. 420dc.

Rnd 2: 1ch, 1htr in every st to next ch-2sp, (1htr, ch2, 1htr) in next ch-2sp, rep from \* to end, sl-st to 1st htr. 428htr.

Rnd 3: As rnd 2. 436htr.

Fasten off.

#### **Front Edging**

With **RS** of blanket facing and **A**, starting from the top left corner, work a standing dc in between the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> st from the edge, in the same place as the dc worked on **WS** for Back Edging, placing the dc before the dc from **WS**. Cont to work around Blanket. (412dc in total and 4ch-2sps.)

Rnds 1-3: As for Back Edging.

Do not fasten off.

#### **Joining Edging**

1ch, join front and back edging by working dc through corresponding sts of both edges to corner, work (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) in corner ch-sp working through both front and back ch-sps, rep along all edges, sl-st in 1st dc, fasten off.
