Hormonal Therapy

Take home points



- Hormonal therapy tries to starve the cancer cells of nutrients to stop the cancer from growing. (Blocking the gas line.)
- Types of hormonal therapy include Selective Estrogen Receptor Modulators (SERMs), Selective Estrogen Receptor Degraders (SERDs), and Aromatase Inhibitors.
- Hormonal therapy is usually recommended for patients with ER and PR positive cancers.
- Hormonal therapy medications are typically taken for 5 to 10 years.
