Recurrent Cancer

Take home points



- Recurrent disease can occur anytime, months to many years after the original diagnosis of a cancer. (A dandelion can grow back at any time.)
- Recurrent disease is classified as either a local recurrence or distant recurrence.
- Each type of recurrence is treated very differently; the prognosis and available treatment options vary greatly.
