# HYPERINSULINISM

The Children's Hyperinsulinism Charity formed in February 2016 by 5 passionate parents who wanted to make a difference to the way support was available to other families of children living with Congenital Hyperinsulinism.

Our aim is to be raise more awareness of the condition and give support back to the CHI community which we ourselves received throughout our own children's journeys from diagnosis.

Congenital Hyperinsulinism is a rare medical condition affecting approximately 1:40,000 births. It is the overproduction of the hormone insulin and the main cause of persistent and severe Hypoglycaemia (low blood sugars). Left undetected and without immediate medical treatment, children are at risk of neurological consequences, seizures and possible coma or death. It can present differently for every child making detection difficult, but once diagnosed, it is a constant condition with children living their lives full of medical and feeding regimes, various therapies as well as numerous hospital admissions and further testing.

Our Facebook support group has been running for over 7 years and has grown in members both nationally and internationally. We understand what hurdles they come across every day such as feeding issues, applying for funds, equipment, behaviour and school transitions for example.

Our conferences and social events give our families a chance to learn from the medical experts and meet other families who know and understand what living

within Hyperinsulinism is like. There is no greater gift for our families than being with others that understand and helps them to feel less isolated and know they are not alone.

We are privileged to be able to work closely with the 3 Specialist Hyperinsulinism Teams in the UK at Great Ormond Street Hospital, Manchester Children's Hospital and Alder Hev and help to fund further research for them into medications, monitoring equipment and more importantly finding a cure.

#### **Alliza-Lily Story:**

Alliza-Lily arrived 3 weeks early weighing a whopping 9lbs 11oz. She was born by emergency C-Section due to being in breech position and her head being large. She slept, fed and didn't cry. She was perfect!!

Once home, she continued just the same but I had a few concerns that she was not feeding as well as she should and mentioned this to my midwife. I was told to strip her back to her vest and hold her away from me to feed as, "babies can be lazy and like nothing more than cuddles with mum".

I continued doing as advised and when Alliza-Lily was 6 days old, she fell blue and lifeless at home, with her breathing being very slow and laboured. I telephoned for an ambulance and Ian Pratt, EMAS paramedic arrived by Fast Response Vehicle within 4 minutes of my call. He immediately requested emergency back up and conducted a blood sugar test which showed a very low reading and administered Glucagon and oxygen. We were immediately rushed to A&E at Kettering General Hospital where a team of paediatric doctors were waiting for us.

Thankfully, and I count my blessings every day, Kettering General had seen the condition before in a handful of patients and knew what they were dealing with. We were told that had lan not arrived as quick as he did, Alliza-Lily would not have survived. After 6 days in KGH SCBU, Alliza-Lily was transferred to Great Ormond Street Hospital where numerous tests were carried out and the diagnosis made.

Today, Alliza-Lily is 6 years old, still on medication for her Hyperinsulinism and has development and learning delays. She continues to be supported by teams at KGH and Great Ormond Street and although she has many challenges. Alliza-Lily delights everyone who crosses her path, is mischievous with a huge,

infectious personality.

Our beautiful sunshine Jorgie was sadly taken away in October 2016, just two weeks before her 2nd birthday. Unfortunately, in her short lifetime, Jorgie was no stranger to medical visits and had her very own 'Be Brave Bear' that accompanied her on these visits. This provided a lot of comfort and joy to her during difficult times.

Since Jorgie's passing, we have set up 'Jorgie's Buddies', donating these 'Be Brave Bears' to local children with life-limiting, life-threatening and/or terminal illness. Each Bear is personalised with the individual child's name and accompanied with a certificate, in recognition of the child's bravery. The feedback we have received from families, as well as medical professionals is overwhelming.

The Bears have become huge sources of comfort to these children attending doctor's/hospital appointments and/or when receiving extremely painful but life-saving treatments. It's been reported that the Bears have helped to ensure the children feel a little less scared. For us, this means that Jorgie is working her magic to help her 'Buddies' in times of need.

We deliver each bear personally to the child and it's wonderful to see the true meaning of 'Jorgie's Buddies' and the happiness it brings. In doing so, along with personal experiences, we understand how difficult their situations can be; providing complicated care needs for their child 24-7. 'Jorgie's Buddies' has set up a Facebook page to help these families to gain the much needed support and guidance they

seek. People are always on hand to help and offer well wishes to children when they are admitted to the hospital. The feedback from the families have been fantastic, stating that it helps them to feel included and that they're not alone.

To date, we have delivered 240 bears to children with a variety of illnesses and conditions. This is through lots of generous donations and we aim to continue providing this joy to the children and their families.

# West Glebe Park



#### Volunteer Coordinator


This role will develop processes and volunteering opportunities at Teamwork Trust and in the community.







# Looking after your lungs

Our lungs are designed to absorb oxygen from the air we breathe, so that it can be used by our bodies to give us energy. There are some common long term conditions which affect the lungs and respiratory system which mean your lungs do not work as well as they should. This can result in you feeling short of breath, having a tight chest, having a cough, hearing a wheezing noise on breathing out, or the production of sputum and all this can affect your daily activities.

- Asthma is a condition where the small airways constrict which usually produces a wheeze. Asthma can affect children and adults and is more common in people who have allergies or where there is a family history of Asthma.
- COPD occurs most commonly in smokers and ex smokers and usually results in a cough, increased sputum production and frequent chest infections.
- Bronchiectasis is a condition where the lungs accumulate sputum and the person usually gets frequent chest infections.

 Babies and small children sometimes develop a temporary wheezy chest when they have viral infections. Each winter there is usually an outbreak of Bronchiolitis which is a type of viral infection which usually affects smaller children or babies. Children with a wheeze occurring during and after viral infections such as Bronchiolitis may require inhalers and other respiratory medications when they are small, although many children will grow out of this problem by the time they are at school and may not develop Asthma as an older child or adult.

Most people who do not have a long term lung condition will be able to manage their symptoms with self-care if they have a few days of a cough or a cold, and you can buy cheap simple remedies such as paracetamol in a supermarket or at a pharmacy. Sometimes breathing problems can become more serious. If you or someone close to you is having difficulty breathing seeing any

of these the signs mean that you need to call a 999 ambulance:

- 1) being so short of breath that you are unable to talk in sentences,
- 2) turning blue around the mouth,
- 3) drooling and being unable to swallow due to breathing problems,
- 4) finding you are so exhausted by the effort of breathing that it is making you sleepy.

If you have a long term respiratory condition make sure you attend your GP practice for your annual check and remember to order your regular medication in good time.



Your healthcare professional will help you to understand how to best manage your lung condition, and may prescribe inhalers and other medications. It is important that you know when and how to take the medication, since some inhalers need to be used regularly where others are to be used only when you are short of breath. You will be given advice about when to call for help if you have problems with your breathing. You may be given antibiotics or steroids to keep at home so that you can treat vourself promptly. If you are under the care of the Rocket respiratory outreach team, make sure you follow their advice including knowing when to contact them. If you have a long term lung/breathing condition is important for you get your flu jab, and pneumonia jab if eligible. These important vaccinations will be available in your GP practice from the middle of September.

If you have been coughing for more than 3 weeks or have coughed up

blood, particularly if you are a smoker, make an appointment at your GP practice since this may need investigating even if you do

not have a diagnosis of a long term respiratory condition. They will want to do checks to look for infection, lung cancer and other lung conditions.

You can keep your lungs as healthy as possible by a few simple measures. Avoiding cigarette smoke is really important, vaping is probably safer for your lungs than smoking but can still be addictive. It really helps your breathing if you can exercise regularly, play a wind instrument (if you can) and sing whenever you get a chance either along with the radio or you may prefer to sing with a group. A group we have in Corby specifically for people (and their Carers) with respiratory conditions such as asthma and COPD is Singing4 breathing:

If you do smoke and can manage to stop it can prevent your lungs from deteriorating, if you need help to quit smoking a pharmacist can help you. Stopping smoking is particularly important if you have one or more long term health conditions. Long term conditions can be managed better if you are in control, so ask your general practice team how you can best look after your own health and stay as well as possible.


#### **Favourite place in Corby**




