このキットに含まれている刺しゅう糸は図案通りに刺していただければ足りる糸量に、余裕を持たせてセットされています。刺し始める前に、この作り方説明書をよくお読みください。刺し間違い、糸の選び間違い、布裏での糸の渡し過ぎ等により糸が足りなくなる場合があります。その場合は、色番をご確認のうえ、お近くのオリムパス刺しゅう糸取扱店にてお求めください。

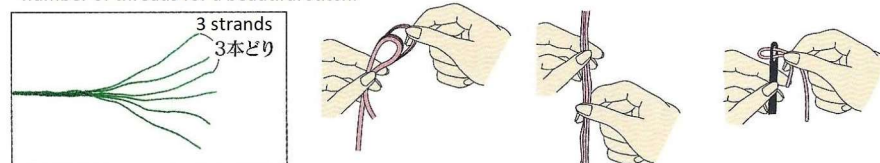
1. Before stitching

How to handle embroidery thread

Cut the thread to a length that is easy to use. It will be easier to use 0.5m for detailed designs and 1m for continuous designs.

One #25 floss is made by loosely twisting 6 thin threads.

To make the thread bulge, pull it out one by one to loosen the thread, and use it after arranging the required number of threads for a beautiful stitch.



The #25 floss is made by loosely twisting 6 thin threads. Pull out some of these thin threads and call it 「○ strands」.

① Fold the thread in half and pull out the required number of threads one by one from the pile.

② Align the threads.

③ Pass the end of the thread in a loop through the needle hole.

2. Before stitching

About the beginning and end of #25 floss.

● How to use thread

〈How to make a knot〉

If you are not accustomed to handling threads and needles, it will be easier to stitch if you make a knot.

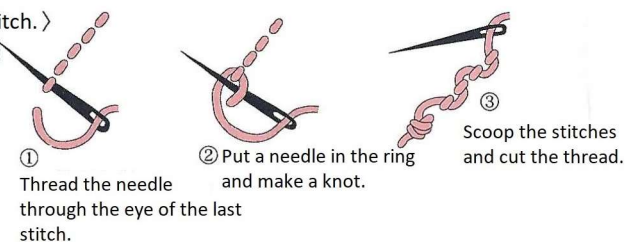
As shown in the figure on the right, wind the thread 2 to 3 times on the needle and pull out the needle.

※ It is recommended to get used to the method of entwining the thread below.

〈How to thread the last eye of a stitch.〉

Leave 5 - 7 cm of thread at the beginning of the stitch, Thread the thread behind the stitch.

Tie a knot at the end as shown in the figure, or thread some stitches through the back thread.



① Thread the needle through the eye of the last stitch.

② Put a needle in the ring and make a knot.

③ Scoop the stitches and cut the thread.

Materials

材料

- Embroidery cloth / NO.6500 Emmy cloth #105 Off white
(Printed designs may bleed when wet.)
- Thread / #25 floss
- Other materials / Backing cloth, Wrapping board, Thick paper, Brooch pin
- Needle / Embroidery needle (Please handle with care.)

※ The cloth of No.6500 #105 contains cottonregs to take advantage of the natural texture.

What to prepare

- Hand-sewn thread ● Sewing needle ● Scissors ● Pen ● Handicraft Glue

※ It may be convenient to have an embroidery frame.

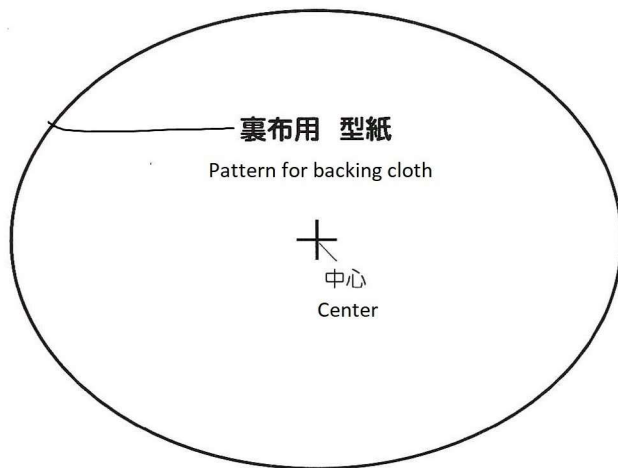

Real size pattern

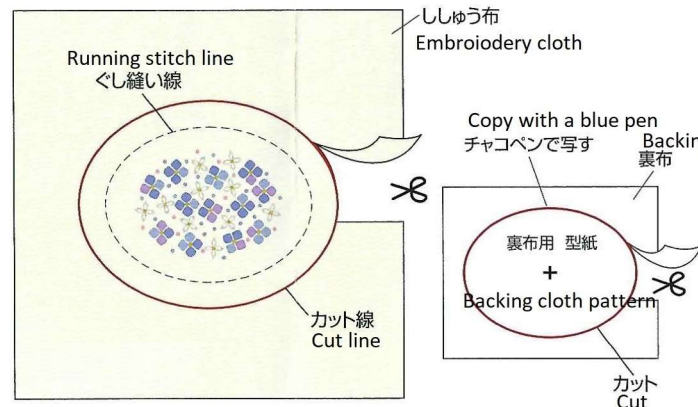

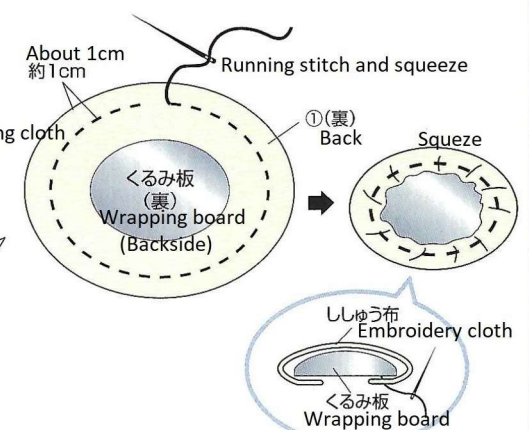
Back cloth cut line



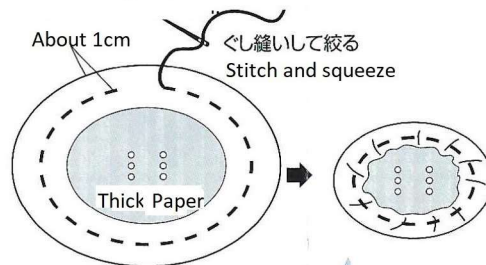
- ① Cut the cloth according to the cut line of the print.
Cut the backing cloth according to the pattern.



- ② Sew the circumference with hand-sewn thread along the print, insert a wrapping board and squeeze.

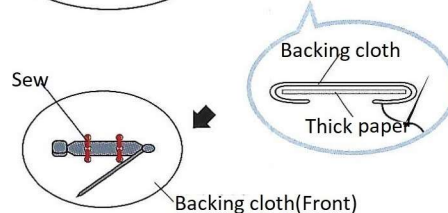
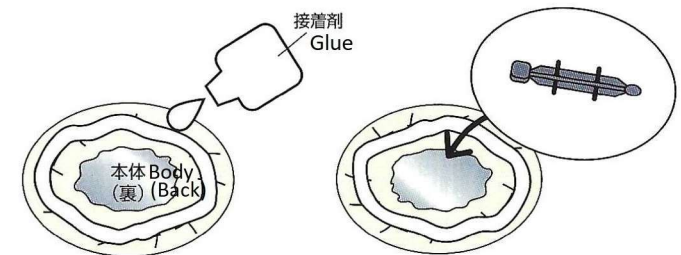


- ③ Similarly, insert thick paper into the backing cloth and the squeeze it.
Insert the needle into the hole in the cardboard and sew the brooch pin

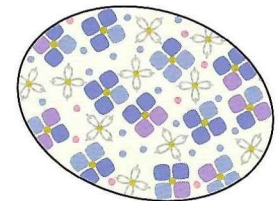


- ④ Apply ※glue around ②

- ⑤ Paste ③ together



Finish



注意 Note

※ Hold it firmly until the adhesive dries.

※ "Synthetic rubber" adhesive is recommended for bonding the main body and the wrapping board.

Do not use or store in places subject to water or high humidity. Leaving it wet or dirty may cause rust.

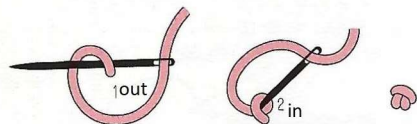


"Stitches"

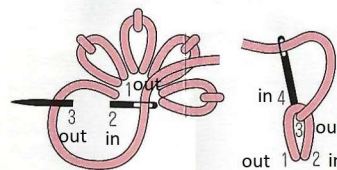


French knot Stitch



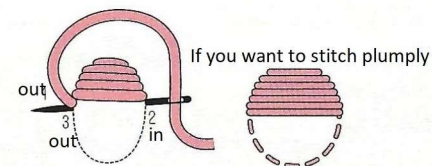
Wrap the thread once or twice around the needle that came out of 1. Insert the needle perpendicular to 2 and tighten the thread before pulling out the needle.

Lazy Daisy Stitch



Stitch softly so as not to pull the thread too much. When stitching the corners, finish the stitch and start stitching again in the loop.

Satin Stitch



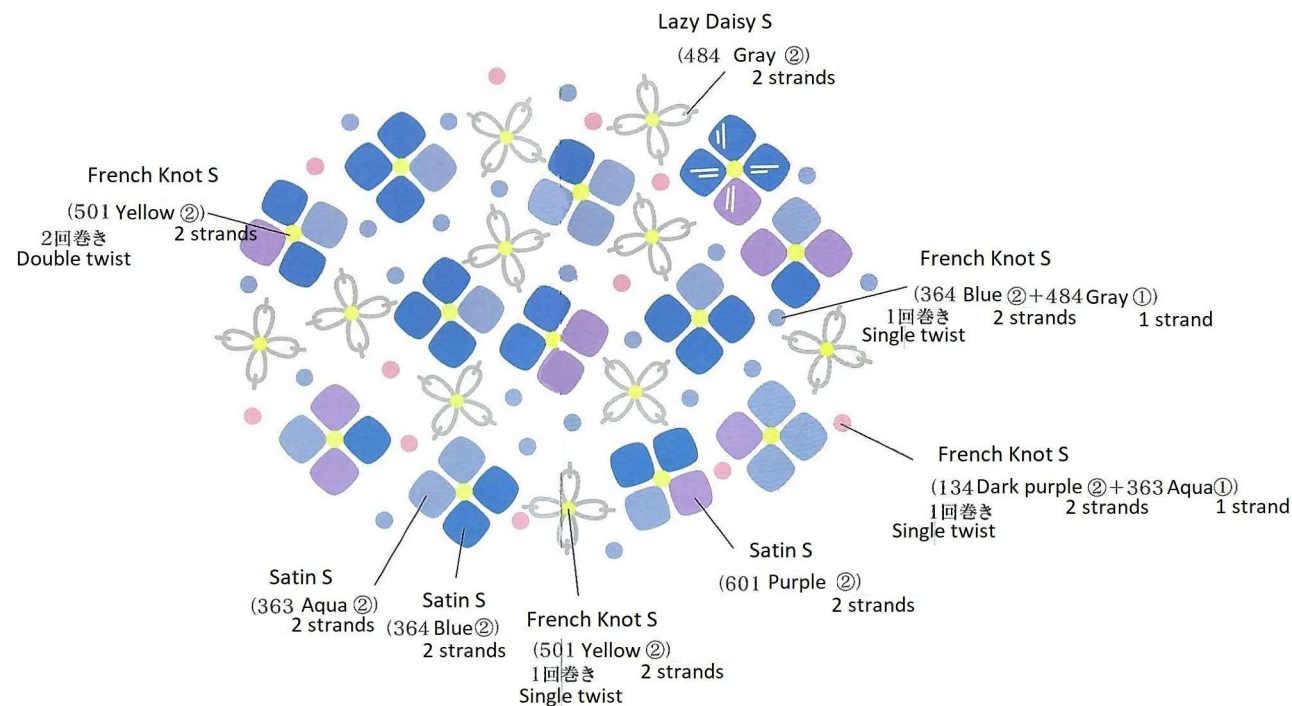
Stitch evenly so that the threads do not overlap along the lines of the pattern. When stitching round objects, stitch from the center to the outside, then stitch the rest.

Design

Let's stitch with reference to the design and cover image.

〈S= Stitch〉○ is the number of threads. (Example : ②= 2 strands)
