

DISPLAY AND BUTTONS



SETTING THE TIME

- 1. Pull the crown out to the 2nd Click Position.
- 2. Turn the crown clockwise to set hour and minute hands.
- 3. After the time has been set, push the crown back to the Normal position.

SETTING THE DATE

- 1. Pull the crown out to the 1st Click Position.
- Turn the crown clockwise to set the date.
 * If the date is set between the hours of around 9:00 PM and 1:00 AM, the date may not change on the following day.
- 3. After the date has been set, push the crown back to the Normal position.




This chronograph is able to measure and display time in 1/4 second united up to maximum of 59min 59sec.

[Measuring time with the stopwatch]


1. Press button "A" to start the chronograph.

2. The chronograph can be started and stopped each time button "A" is pressed.

3. Press button "B" to reset the chronograph and chronograph minute and second hands return to their Zero positions







CHRONOGRAPH RESET (INCL. AFTER REPLACING BATTERY)

This procedure should be performed when the chronograph second hand does not return to the Zero position.

1. Pull the crown out to the 2nd Click Position.

2. Press the button "A" once to set the chronograph second hand to the Zero position.

* The chronograph hand can be advanced rapidly by continuously pressing button "A".

3. Once the hands are set at Zero position, reset the time and return the crown to its normal position.





> Cleaning

Clean your watch regularly as follows; this will maintain its aesthetic appeal and ensure it stays in good working order.

- Ensure that the crown is completely screwed down before you get started.
- Avoid contact with detergents, solvents, cosmetics or any other chemical product, as these may damage the water-resistant gaskets and the bracelet.
- If you have any doubts whatsoever about the water resistance of your watch, simply clean it with a soft brush, and then dry it.

> CONDENSATION

A small amount of condensation may form under the crystal of your watch if there is a sudden temperature change. This mist will disappear by itself and will not impact the watch function. If the condensation persists, please contact FUTLOV watches.

CRYSTALS

The crystal in your watch may be coated with an anti-reflective treatment (single or double), to make the time more readable. Marks may appear due to normal wear and tear of the watch, and are not covered by the Warranty. The coating will be sufficient if you use your watch normally.

> WATER RESISTANCE

Given the nature of rubber seals, water resistance cannot be a permanent condition. The rubber seals are designed to prevent water entry, however the fact that they are under constant pressure means that over time they will deteriorate.

LEATHER STRAP

Be sure to avoid letting the watch get into contact with water. Please note that no matter how careful you are with leather, it is a living material and its colour will naturally (slightly) fade or darken over time. Leather straps should be cleaned with a dry, soft cotton cloth. Avoid any abrasive products during cleaning
