

# HANDY RING SIZER

1. Make sure this sizer is printed at the right size! Use a ruler to confirm the length of these lines. This is VERY IMPORTANT! :)

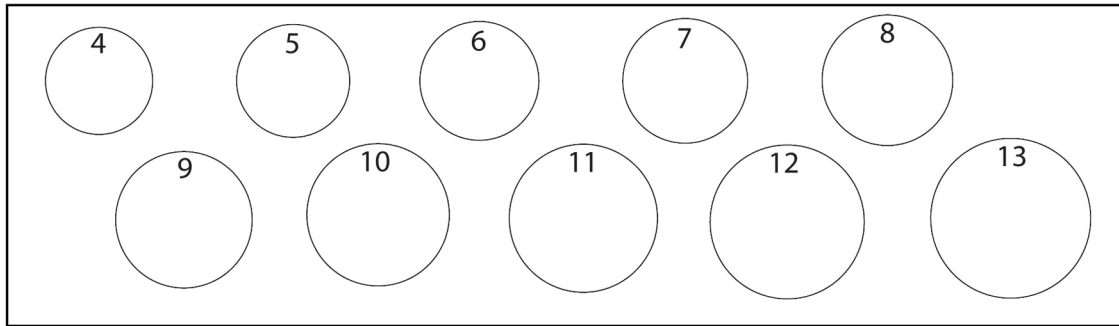


2. Choose a method to determine the correct ring size. Our favorite is A.

## METHOD A: Measure an existing ring.

Use a ring that you know to fit well. Place it on the circles below. The correct sized circle will fit right along the INSIDE of the ring.



## METHOD B: Measure finger with string.

Use a string that is not stretchy- like regular dental floss. Measure the thickest part of the finger, which may be the knuckle. Exactly one loop around the finger is the circumference.

## METHOD C: Use this paper sizer.

Carefully cut out the sizer below and cut a small slit EXACTLY on the dashed line. Slip the pointed end through the slit, with the numbers facing out. Place the sizer comfortably around the thickest part of the finger (which may be the knuckle) and secure it with a piece of tape. Make sure you can still slide it on and off, but that it is a snug fit. The ring size is the number that appears near the arrow.
