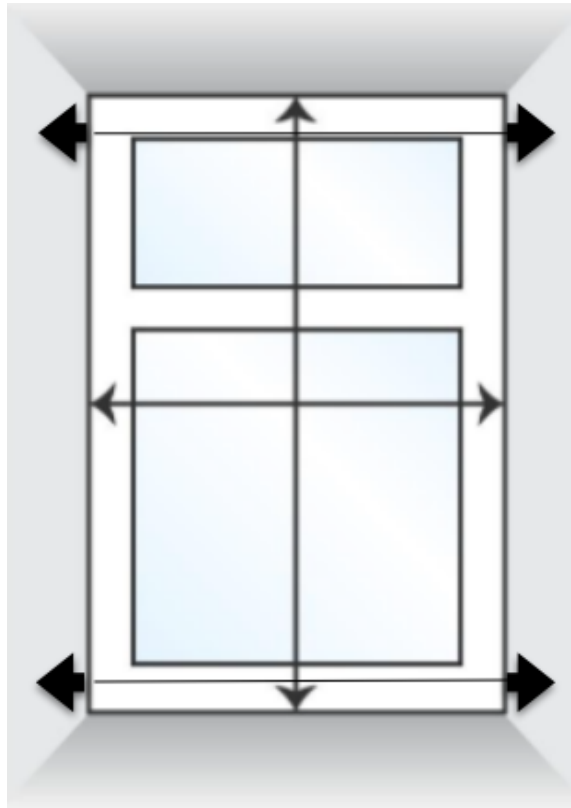


## Measuring For Roman Blinds



Please insert your measurements on the diagram above and we will calculate the rest.

Use a metal tape measure for accuracy. Measure the width at the top, middle and bottom, as it may not be consistent along the entire recess.

To measure the blind length, take the same approach using the metal tape measure from the top of the recess to the windowsill at 3 points.

When measuring for blinds to fit within a recess, please provide the exact recess width measurements. We will make the necessary adjustments for you.

If you want your blinds to sit outside the window, there are some options. Please give us the measurements as above but we like to make the width the same as your windowsill for balance and symmetry, so measure the width of your window sill and add it to the diagram. The top of the blind usually looks best when it's hung at least 10cm above the window reveal. You can attach it higher than this if you have the room and this gives the illusion of the window being taller

**We will need to know if your blind is to be hung inside or outside of the window and which side of the window you would like the chains, left or right.**
