

# JuniorMaker Squirrel Feeder Kit

Your kit comes with all the parts, including hardware, to build your own picnic table squirrel feeder. The parts are all predrilled for easy assembly. The only tool you need is a #2 Robertson (square) bit screwdriver.

### Countersunk Holes

Insert screws into the predrilled holes from the side with the countersink. This countersink allows the head of the screws to sit flush with the wood.



### Step 2

Using two 1½" screws, attach the cross piece to the legs.



### Screws

Attach pieces together by inserting screws until they just start to poke through. Then line the point up with the hole in the other piece.



### Step 3

Flip over the first leg assembly.



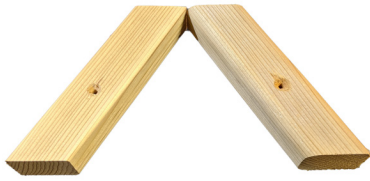
### Step 1

Find the two leg pieces that have the holes at the end of the piece. Arrange them like the picture.



### Step 4

Using two 1½" screws, attach the bench support piece to the legs.



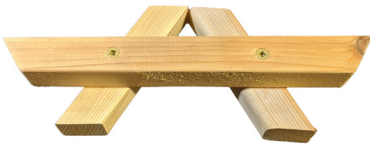
### Step 5

Set aside the first assembly and find the other two legs. Arrange them like the picture. Pay attention that the holes are towards the bottom.



### Step 9

Using four 1½" screws, attach the table to the assembly. Ensure the hole in the end of the table faces the same way as the support piece as shown.



### Step 6

Using two 1½" screws, attach the bench support piece to the legs.



### Step 10

Using one 1½" screw, attach the back piece to the table top. Find the shorter 1" screw.



### Step 7

Using two 1½" screws, attach the first bench piece to the two leg assemblies. Pay attention that the holes are towards the inside edge of the bench piece.



### Step 11

Using the 1" screw, attach the back piece to the support piece.



### Step 8

Using two 1½" screws, attach the second bench piece to the leg assemblies. Pay attention that the holes are towards the inside edge of the bench piece.



### Step 12

Use one of the 2" screws up through the table to mount a corn cob, or attach a plastic tray/cup for food. Use the last two 2" screws to attach to table to a fence or tree.
