

## **Installation Guide**

- 1. Push the latch to release the access door.
- 2. Loosen the M10 screws before sliding the fixture onto the tenon.
- 3. Slip the fixture onto the tenon, search for approximate penetration, adjust horizontal angle properly and tighten M10 screws.
- 4. Connect the service leads to the terminal block.
- 5. Turn latch to reinstall the access door and the fixture is ready to be energized.



Horizontal angle can be adjusted in 2.5° steps, ±5°
