




FIXING SUPPORTS

Mark and fix the supports in the desired position. Space the supports evenly and position one support close to the end of the rail for extra strength and stability.



Practical Tip: Do NOT fix the rail to the supports until the blind is attached.







HANGING THE BLIND



Attach the Loop Tape to the back of the front blind, fix the curtain tape and blind rods to the back as normal.


Attach the front blind to the hook tape on the back of the rail as shown.












When cutting the rail cut from the end without the cords. Loosen the end cap screw as shown and slide out the end cap (a). If you are cutting a longer length, you may need to loosen the cord guide (b) and slide it out of the way before cutting.



Cut the rail and replace the end cap.



Please Note: After cutting you may need to re-position the cord guides so they are in line with the Roman Blind Tape Pockets. To do this simply loosen the screw and slide left or right before tightening the screw to secure in new position.
