BIOGRAPHY

New academic painter, Dominique Normand, lives in the Laurentians, Québec. She celebrates the beauty of Canadian Wilderness and its true Spirit. Her paintings speak a vibrant language; they reveal in a daring suggested fashion simple observations of precious moments in time and draw attention to the sacred gifts of life. Instinctively, she creates her own transformational path as a practice in living her intentions, a deep knowing of the soul leading the way.

Dominique says she was lucky to be brought up in Nature, and still responds to Nature like a need to be fulfilled; she needs to be in the woods, to sit by the river and the fire, to head up North where the wild things are, to look for bones, find that cave, smell the wet forest floor, to listen to Raven and desperately needs to paint that marsh. In Nature, she comes alive. Her paintings are fragments of her story and the worlds she visits in a passionate manner.

Her strong, visceral bond with native culture has led her to inquire and research through her roots on her father' side. The region of Montmagny was a frequent passage for the Nomadic Malicet and Mi'kmaq Natives of Eastern Quebec and New Brunswick. In 2012, she discovered she is Metis of Maliseet descent.

Dominique's work has been showcased in many solo and group exhibitions such as 11 Nations cultural center, Galerie Richelieu in Montréal, Saint Adolphe's Manifest'Art in the Laurentians, Montmagny's Rendez-Vous Ononthio, Broadway Gallery in New York, Westin Hotel in Los Angeles, Soutana Galerie and Jardin d'Hiver in Mont Tremblant, art galleries in Montebello, St-Jovite, Saint Sauveur, Piedmont, Horse Show Classique de Blainville and many more.

ARTIST STATEMENT

In painterly manners, she translates in images, the omnipresent powers that imprint and shape the world of human experience in the heart of the Northern territories. Since 2008, she has visited, lived and built strong ties with the Cree people of James Bay. The sum of these precious encounters and the teachings she has thus received constitute an everlasting reservoir of powerful inspiration for her creation. Enriched by her own experience amongst the Cree communities and her own life awareness revelations, she becomes a witness to the entwined harmony of all our relations, a spokeswoman bearing a camera, armed with a brush, painting,

documenting video. A mystic universe is born on canvas, revealing the fascination she feels for the land and the territories that possess her. Magic works both ways! Dominique stands out for her strong visually evocative works, her holistic and sensitive vision of the worlds around her.

CANADA C3 EFFECT

There is so much to say about the CanadaC3 experience. It is human, it is monumental, vital, and deeply transforming. I have been back for months now, but the emotions and memories are barely starting to come back like a heavy tide on the shore of my consciousness.

It took me a while to understand and measure the effects of the expedition on my life as a human being and as an artist. The answers came through my work, one painting at the time, revealing secrets I wasn't yet aware of: grief, sadness, awe, wonder, loss, renewal, exasperation, anger, compassion and so much more.

It truly was a trip of a lifetime. I will never be the same. In French, the word "co-naissance" really means to be born again with knowledge, this is what is happening. I am renewed with facts, feelings, emotions and new awareness of the bigger picture.

This new collection of works speaks of deeper knowing of the unseen, the underworld, the truths revealed by face to face encounters with the people of the North who greeted us with generosity and pride, a better understanding of what is at stake environmentally, the incomparable beauty of Canada's North.

I will be forever grateful for this unique chance I had to be part of this project, thank you from a deep place in my heart.
