ARTIST STATEMENT

Landscapes dominate the subjects of my paintings, simply because they have always surrounded my life. Feeling is the essential motif behind my work; the initial inspiration holds the key to the process that evolves afterwards. I am drawn to a particular place by a luminous colour, a certain slant of light, an interesting shape, or shadow, movement of sky, a memory of sound, smell and sense of ease. These elements are what interest and excite me, stirring my passion to paint.

For me these places are found in northern Ontario. After graduating from the Ontario College of Art in 95, painting the north was a natural homecoming for me. Growing up it was where I spent my summers and weekends. Growing older I've realized the impact it made on my life and work.

Recently I relocated my home and studio from Toronto to Lakefield ON, in the Kawarthas, to be closer to my inspiration. When painting, I reference photos I've taken usually only days prior so the image and feeling is still fresh in my mind. Each piece starts as a small oil sketch, where I focus on colour and composition, this then may or may not lead to a larger canvas. I try to paint every day. This is important for my work as well as my well-being.

HORIZONS - CURATORIAL STATEMENT

Wall Space Gallery invites you to join us for the presentation of new paintings by four renowned landscape artists; <u>Tanya Kirouac</u>, <u>Peter Rotter</u>, <u>Dan Ryan</u> and <u>Boyd Waites</u>. Through their unique approaches, each of these artists explore the use of the horizon line, whether through its stark presence or its abstract denial, to tether us to reality or allow us to drift into psychological spaces of reverie.

A horizon line in painting is often considered the most basic descriptor of space, grounding abstract environment into 'land' and 'sky' - "up" and "down". In his realism, Peter Rotter is bound by the horizon, using it as a means to fragment the canvas into varying portions drawing us to open sky or pulling us earthwards as in Sunset Island. Rotter likewise withholds deep space from us

In The Stand, he focuses instead on rough textures of bark that push towards us, obscuring the horizon but leading us through multiple shallow drifts of snow.

Rotter loosens or amplifies the grip of gravity and space to allow painting to connect with the sensorial experience of place. The power in Rotter's approach to disorientation or grounding through the horizon lies in his ability to shake us loose from our everyday experience of the world.
