Welcome to our week of crafting while in quarantine! We, like many you, are working from home and trying our best to stay focused, while also enjoying a little down time with family, and thought it would be fun to offer some ideas and instruction to some of the cute projects we have posted so that you can create right alongside us!

For our Monday craft, we're sharing how we created 5, quick and easy, cards that are perfect for dropping a quick note in the mail or on a neighbors porch to brighten their day! We hope you'll enjoy following along and share your projects with us, too!

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Supplies used:

White and/or Kraft Cardstock for card bases (cut to 5.5" wide x 8.5" tall/then folded to be 4.25" tall for front)

A Cherry on Top 6x8 Paper Pad

A Cherry on Top Ephemera Pack

A Cherry on Top Tags Pack

A Cherry on Top Chipboard

A Cherry on Top Felt Pieces

A Cherry on Top Puffy Dot Stickers

15 Cents Card Instructions: For this card we used a white card base (see size info above). Trim your floral paper down to a 5.25 x 4" piece and adhere to the center of card front. From your tags pack, select the blue/pink tag (as seen in photo) and place it about .75" from the right edge of your paper. Next, layer pieces using dimensional adhesives. From your ephemera pack use the floral piece, the yellow ticket and the 15 piece and layer as shown!

Flower Accent Card Instructions: For this card we used a white card base (see size info above). Trim your cone/brown checkered paper down to a 5.25 x 4" piece and adhere to the center of card front. Also trim a 5.25 x 1" piece of floral to layer along the bottom of the brown paper and a striped piece (from the cut apart paper) to fit on top of the floral (as seen in photo). Next, from your tags pack, find the white/yellow tag (as seen in photo) and place it about 1.25" in from the left side of the card, just overlapping the striped piece of paper. The "yummy" and "living the sweet life" word strips are from the cut apart paper also. Layer them as shown using dimensional adhesives! Last, add the final touches with your larger felt flower and a mixture of colored puffy dot stickers as shown!

Spring Card Instructions: For this card we used a white card base (see size info above). Trim your yellow sunshine/starburst paper to 5.25 x 4" and adhere to center of card front. Next, from the ephemera pack, use the word "SPRING" and adhere with dimensional adhesives to the lower area of the card front, centered. Next, from your chipboard, add the small green heart accent to tuck in above the "N". Last, wrap a couple of bakers twine pieces through the card and tie bows!

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Sweet Card Instructions: For this card we used a kraft card base (see size info above). Trim your red and pink/ graphic paper down to a 5.25 x 4" piece and adhere to the center of card front. From your tags pack, select the kraft/white striped tag and place about .5" in from the right side of the paper as shown. Next, from your chipboard pieces, add the word "Sweet" along with the pink heart for accenting. Last, from your ephemera pack, add a cute butterfly to the upper left area of the tag using dimensional adhesive.

Yummy! Card Instructions: For this card we used a kraft card base (see size info above). Trim your cute text paper down to a 5.25 x 4" piece and adhere to the center of card front. From your tags pack, select the mint and pink tag (as seen in photo) and place about .25" in from the right side of the paper as shown. Next, from your chipboard pieces, add the cute ice cream treat to the lower right area of the tag. Also, from your tags pack, take the red, round, 'YUMMY!' tag and slightly layer it over your other tag in the upper left area as shown, using dimensional adhesives. Last, tie a bow with twine to your main tag, using the string in your tag set for the other tag. Add a few puffy dot stickers to the card front as shown!

These are quick and easy cards that are fun to create, fun to give away and will hopefully help you share joy during these times! Thanks for joining us and we hope these basic instructions can help you with ideas and ways to enjoy some extra time at home...we'll be back with more tomorrow!
